Verses on Unity

Psalm 133:1 (KJV)

Behold, how good and how pleasant *it is* for brethren to dwell together in unity!

Isaiah 52:8 (KJV)

Thy watchmen shall lift up the voice; with the voice together shall they sing: for they shall see eye to eye, when the LORD shall bring again Zion.

Matthew 23:8 (KJV)

But be not ye called Rabbi: for one is your Master, *even* Christ; and all ye are brethren.

Acts 4:32 (KJV)

And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any *of them* that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

Romans 12:16 (KJV)

Be of the same mind one toward another. Mind not

high things, but condescend to men of low estate. Be not wise in your own conceits.

Romans 14:19 (KJV)

Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.

Romans 15:5-6 (KJV)

Now the God of patience and consolation grant you to be likeminded one toward another according to Christ Jesus: That ye may with one mind *and* one mouth glorify God, even the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 1:10 (KJV)

Now I beseech you, brethren, by the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye all speak the same thing, and *that* there be no divisions among you; but *that* ye be perfectly joined together in the same mind and in the same judgment.

2 Corinthians 13:11 (KJV)

Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

Ephesians 4:3 (KJV)

Endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.

Philippians 1:27 (KJV)

Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel

of Christ: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel;

Philippians 2:2 (KJV)

Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, *being* of one accord, of one mind.

Philippians 3:16-17 (KJV)

Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing. Brethren, be followers together of me, and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

1 Peter 3:8 (KJV)

Finally, *be ye* all of one mind, having compassion one of another, love as brethren, *be* pitiful, *be* courteous:
