



## LESSON 5: GOD GIVES RUTH AND NAOMI A GOOD FRIENDSHIP

### CRAFT: BEST FRIEND KEYCHAINS

#### Supplies

- [Jigsaw Puzzle handout](#)
- acrylic paint, stickers, markers, crayons, sticky jewels, etc
- kitchen trash bags, to protect your clothes
- paintbrushes (for acrylic paint)
- hole punches
- scissors
- yarn or ribbon
- 2 carabiners or keychain rings
- newspaper or disposable tablecloth

#### Easy Prep

- Cover your table with newspaper or a disposable tablecloth.
- Cut slits in the trash bags to make a head hole and arm holes.



#### Make Keychains

For our craft, you'll each need two puzzle pieces, from the jigsaw puzzle handout that fit together.

Follow these steps:

- Connect the two puzzle pieces, and paint/decorate a fun pattern or design on them.
- Write "Best Friends" or "God gives us friends" across the connected pieces.
- Take the pieces apart. Use a hole punch or scissors to poke a hole in an end of each piece. Ask for assistance.
- Thread a small length of yarn or ribbon through each hole.
- For each puzzle piece, thread the yarn through a carabiner/keychain and knot the ends.

## Talk About It

Keep one and give the other to a friend.

Who do you want to give your puzzle piece to? What do you like about that friend?

Good friends are kind of like connecting puzzle pieces. God gives us friends that just fit together. Ruth and Naomi fit together, even though they were different ages and from different places. Ruth promised to be loyal to Naomi, and she helped Naomi get food to eat. Because Ruth stuck with Naomi, she met Boaz, who she later married. God gives us friends.
