

LESSON 11: JESUS HEALS TEN MEN OF LEPROSY CRAFT: THANK-YOU BOOMERANGS

Supplies

- 7x7 pieces of craft foam
- Thank-You Boomerang handout
- scissors
- pens
- markers



Make a Boomerang

We've been learning that when Jesus healed 10 men with leprosy, only one came back to thank him.

Who has ever heard of a boomerang? What does it do? How is that like today's story?

We're going to make boomerangs to remind us that we can always go to Jesus to say thank you because <u>Jesus deserves our thanks</u>.

Cut out the X-shaped boomerang on their handout and then trace it onto your craft foam. Then cut the shape out of the craft foam. Throw away handouts once the craft foam boomerangs are created.

Decorate

Write the Bible Point—<u>Jesus deserves our thanks</u>—on boomerangs. You can also write things you're thankful for and add fun decorations such as dots, swirls, or triangles. You can decorate both sides of your boomerang.

Throw It

Try throwing your boomerang in an open area. To get the boomerang to come back, hold the boomerang at a 45-degree angle by one leg, then flick their wrist to launch it. It may take some practice to get the boomerang

to come back. That's okay! If you throw it and it doesn't return, think about the nine men who didn't come back to thank Jesus.

Talk About It

Think about a time you went out of your way to thank someone. When the men with leprosy were healed, it took effort to go back and say thank you to Jesus. Only one man turned around like your boomerang and gave thanks. But <u>Jesus deserves our thanks</u>. Let's always remember to thank Jesus for his love for us.
