Application Questions

Bible Study for Next “First Things” Scripture (Galatians 2:20-4:7) looking for the influence of the Holy Spirit, identity and mission of Jesus, and the response of belief and obedience of the Galatians.

Some Notes on Galatians 2:20-4:7 to Help your Discussion:

1. Paul describes his relationship with Christ as him no longer living, but Christ living in him, how does he explain that in Galatians?
2. In looking at Paul’s explanation of how we are saved in Galatians, what is the relationship of the Holy Spirit with the Gospel, Grace and Obedience?
3. Baptism, as in Acts 2, is part of the faith response to Christ, what new things do we learn about baptism in Galatians that were not mentioned in Acts 2?
