Good morning Immanuel Kids!!

I wonder what we are going to talk about today? Look at the pictures below to find out. What are those insects?





Yes, those are grasshoppers!! Have you ever seen one up close? They sure are small aren't they?!



What part of the grasshopper is this? Yes, it is the grasshopper's leg!




What part of the grasshopper is this? Right again! It is the grasshopper's head. What is that brown circle thing on the head? Yes, it is the grasshopper's eye. It is a big eye isn't it?! So, grasshoppers have legs, a head and eyes. Do you have a head? Yes! Do you have legs? Yes! Do you have eyes? Yes, you do. Then you must be a grasshopper, right? Oh no. Silly me, you are not a grasshopper. I am glad you are not a grasshopper!! Our bible story today is about some people who felt as small as grasshoppers. The people in our story felt that everybody was bigger and stronger than they were. Listen to your mom or dad read the story to find out what happened -

Moses and God's people had been traveling for a long time. (Let's pretend like we are traveling - walk in place and swing your arms.)

They were tired because they had come a long way. (Can you pretend like you are tired?)


It had been a hard journey but God had been with them the whole time, protecting them and taking care of them. But look! (Put your hand over your eyes and point in the distance.)



The Promised land! They had finally got to the land God had saved for them. They could see it in the distance and it looked great! (Open your eyes up wide and point to the land.) They could see green fields and lots of trees and rivers and lakes. (Point with your fingers and move your hand around.) They were excited.

But there was a problem. (Hunch over and look upset.) There were already people living there. They could see cities and houses. There just wouldn't be enough land for them and all the people who already lived there. They knew they would have to fight for their new land. Moses wanted to know who was in the new land so he sent 12 men to be spies to go and check it out.

Count the spies in the picture with me - 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12



The spies snuck into the new land (Sshh, tip toe, we have to be quiet.) and checked out all the cities and the people who lived there. They hid behind bushes and rocks and watched the people going in and out of the cities and working in the fields. They couldn't believe their eyes. (Make your eyes really big.) The grape clusters in this new land were so big (Reach up big and tall and spread your arms as far as you can.) that it would take two men to carry one. When they had finally seen enough they collected some food to bring back with them for everyone to see.



When they got back they told the people about all the wonderful things they had seen. Two of the spies, Joshua and Caleb, said that the new land would be a perfect place to live and raise their children. The people were very excited.(Jump up and down and give a high five. Shout 'all right'!) Then the other spies told about what they had seen in the new land. They said that the new land

was a good place to live, but that there was one very big problem. They told them that the people there were giants. (Put your hands over your mouth and say, Oh, no!) They said that they felt like grasshoppers (Bend down and get as small as you can.) among the giant people of this new land. They would get trampled underfoot if they went there. They said, "There is no way we can make them leave their land. (Shake your heads no.) We can't do it. Their cities are surrounded by high walls and are very well guarded. There is no way we can take the cities without all of us being killed. There is just no way, we aren't strong enough. Then the people began to cry. (Pretend to cry.)

Uh-oh, the people in our story forgot something very important. Do you know what that was? They forgot about how God was with them the whole time and had helped them in the past. They forgot that God was on their side and would help them again.

Can you think of a time when God has helped you? Were you ever afraid and God helped you feel better? Did you ever have a time when you thought something was too hard and you wanted to give up? Maybe you were afraid to dunk your head in the water or ride a bike with training wheels or stay in your bed all night long. Those can be hard things to do, but God doesn't want us to give up because things seem hard. He wants us to ask Him for help. God's people in the story gave up because they forgot God would help them. We need to remember that God promised He would be with us and help us.

# Let's pray:

Father God, we thank you for taking care of us and our families. Help us to remember Your promise that You will never leave us. Helps us to remember that we can come to You when we are scared and ask You for help and You will help us because You are on our side. Help us not to feel small like a grasshopper. In Jesus' name. Amen




\*Have kids pretend they are grasshoppers. Do the Grasshopper Wiggle. Have the children hop around pretending that they are tiny grasshoppers in the midst of giants. Hi Immanuel Kids,

How are you this hot, hot, Sunday? Today would be a good day to be in an air conditioned church!! Even though we can't be in church together, doesn't mean we can't still learn together. There is always so much to read about in God's Word, and even the grown-ups don't know it all and we keep growing in our faith just like you guys.

A couple of weeks ago we started learning about the Fruit of the Spirit. What is the Fruit of the Spirit? When we put our faith in Jesus, we receive an amazing gift from God in the form of the Holy Spirit. As the Spirit leads us, we grow and start to bear fruit. It is a way of saying we are becoming more like Jesus. If you couldn't answer the question, that's okay. By the time summer is over, you will be able to. Plus, by the end of summer you will be able to tell me Galatians 5:22-23 by heart. Let's say the verse together now.

"But the Fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law."

Now, tell me what kinds of things make you happy. A puppy or kitten, a new toy or new clothes, going on vacation with your family, a birthday party with friends, going to a sports game, getting a good grade on a test... Those are things that may make you happy. What makes you sad? Being sick or breaking a bone, losing a favorite item, breaking a phone, ipad, or tablet, knowing someone who is sick, the coronavirus... Those are all things that might make you sad. Do you always feel on the inside how you look on the outside? Do sometimes you have a smile on your face when you are really feeling sad on the inside? What if you could always smile on the inside no matter what?

Well, you can! Last week we looked at love and this week we are going to look at joy. Joy is the smile we have on the inside, no matter what is happening around us.

Some people think that being happy and having joy are the same thing, but they are not. We feel happy when something good is happening around us at that moment....like the party or new toys. But this means that being happy doesn't last. It is temporary. One minute something good could be happening and the next minute something bad could be happening and we don't feel happy anymore. Joy is different. Joy doesn't depend on what is happening to us. Joy stays deep down in your heart no matter what!!

God is the source of joy! Psalm 16:11 says, "...You (God) will fill me with joy in Your presence..." God is so good and everything He does is amazing! The more time we spend with God, the better we get to know Him. Think about your good friends. If you didn't spend time getting to know them, would they be your good friends? Probably not. The same is true with God. God loves us and wants us to spend time with Him. When we do, we are filled with joy because of who God is and how He cares for us. Our joy comes from the fact that we know God and He is always with us.

The Bible gives us some good examples of people who were filled with joy as a fruit of the Spirit. Our story today is from the book of Acts. Where is the book of Acts in the Bible? Yes!! The New Testament. Was that too easy a question for you? I will try to ask a harder one next time. Let's read Acts 13:42-52

"As Paul and Barnabas were leaving the synagogue, the people invited them to speak further about these things on the next Sabbath. When the congregation was dismissed, many of the Jews and devout converts to Judaism followed Paul and Barnabas, who talked with them and urged them to continue in the grace of God. On the next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord. When the Jews saw the crowds, they were filled with jealousy and talked abusively against what Paul was saying. Then Paul and Barnabas answered them boldly: 'We had to speak the word of God to you first. Since you reject it and do not consider yourselves worthy of eternal life, we now turn to the Gentiles. For this is what the Lord has commanded us

"I have made you a light for the Gentiles, that you may bring salvation to the ends of the earth."

When the Gentiles heard this, they were glad and honored the word of the Lord; and all who were appointed for eternal life believed. The word of the Lord spread through the whole region. But the Jews incited the God-fearing women of high standing and the leading men of the city. They stirred up persecution against Paul and Barnabas, and expelled them from their region. So they shook the dust from their feet in protest against them and went to Iconium. And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit."

We see in the story that Paul and Barnabas were going around teaching others about Jesus and God's love. It says that the whole town had come out to hear what they had to say. Isn't that amazing!!! Wouldn't it be great if our whole town came out to hear Pastor Brad speak! Anyway... People who listened and believed gave their lives to Jesus and started following the men. Unfortunately, some of the people there didn't believe in Jesus and started saying mean things about Paul and Barnabas. The people who were against Jesus started to plan ways to hurt those who were following Jesus and eventually Paiul and Barnabas were forced to leave Antioch.

At the end of the story the Bible says a very interesting thing. It says: "And the disciples were filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit." – Acts 13.52. WOW! Even though bad things had

happened to them, they were still filled with joy!! What else were they filled with? Yes, they were filled with the Holy Spirit. Joy is a fruit produced by the Holy Spirit being inside of us. Bad things were happening to Paul and Barnabas, but since they knew God, they still had joy deep down inside of their heart!

Remember, we can experience joy when we know God. He is our joy, and the more we know Him, the greater our joy becomes. We can experience joy when we spend time with God praising Him, praying to Him and reading His Word. In His Word we discover His truth, His promises, and who He is.

# PRAYER:

Lord, thank you that our joy comes from knowing You. We know that You are greater than anything bad that might happen to us. Thank you that we can have deep joy inside us even when things are not going well for us and we are sad. In Jesus' name. Amen


In God's Word there are many verses that talk about joy. Since His Word is our truth, it is the first place we should turn to, to learn more about this fruit. Below are some verses about joy.




