What does proclaiming Jesus by teaching everyone with all wisdom imply to you? What was Paul's motive in proclaiming Jesus? (See verse 28b.) What does it take to present people mature in Christ? Who would

What obstacles do you see that are hindering you from becoming mature in Christ in your own life or in the lives of others you are leading? How can you help bring about change? What was the means by which Paul could carry out his ministry? What does his description in verse 29 tell you about ministry and leading others spiritually? How does verse 29 encourage you?
