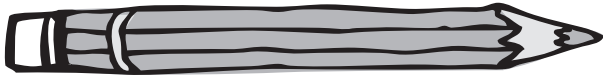

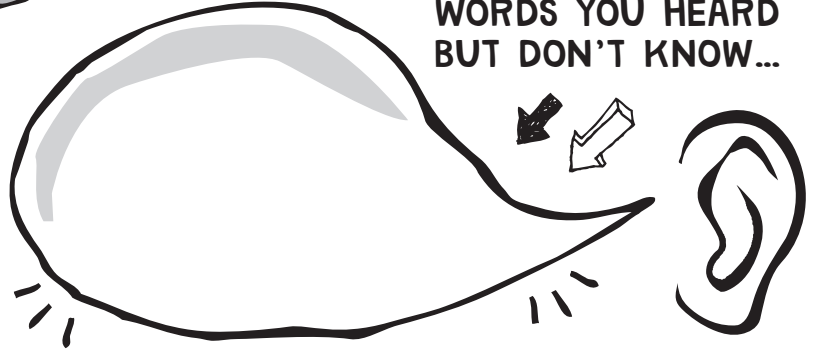

There is always so much to see in the summertime!! All kinds of insects are out and about for us to see and learn about!! Do you know what this is?

It is a moth. This moth is called an underwing moth. It is called this because underneath the brown wings there are beautiful colored wings. Surprise!!



Aren't these wings prettier than the top brown wings!!

We very rarely get to see these moths because they fly around in the dark. Have you ever sat outside near a light when it was dark? What did you see? Did you see that the longer the light was on, the more bugs and moths there were flying around the light? Did you ever go camping? If you've ever did, you probably noticed how the moths came and started flying around your lantern or your fire.

Moths love light, but we don't really know for sure why moths love the lights at night. Some people think maybe the moths are confused. They think that moths use the light from the stars and moon to figure out where they are at night. When the moths fly close to a light they may get confused and think that the light is the sun or moon. No one knows for sure about this, all people know is that moths love light!

When you go to bed, mommy or daddy probably turn off your light so you can sleep better at night. Some people do not like that because it makes their room very dark. Can you see things in the dark? No! If you have to go to the bathroom in the night, can you see where you are going in the dark? Not usually. You probably bump into things as you try to find your way. If you or your mom or dad turn the light switch back on, can you see? Yes!! It makes it easier to walk to the bathroom.

Did you know that Jesus called himself the "Light of the World"? Wherever he went people were attracted to Him, just like moths are attracted to a light at night. Thousands of people would follow Jesus because He gave them hope and healed their bodies and their hearts. He offered forgiveness and a new way of life. In God's special book, the Bible, it says (John 8:12) "When Jesus spoke again to the people, He said, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life'." Jesus is the light. Light helps us know where we are going and when we follow Jesus He is the light that helps us. When we are having trouble or are scared or lonely or even when we do something wrong, we can turn to Jesus, the Light, and He will show us the right way to go.

Did you also know that Jesus wants you to be a light? In the Bible (Matthew 5:14, 16) Jesus said, "You are the light of the world. Let your light shine before men, that they may see your good works, and praise your Father in heaven." What? How can you shine like a light? Do you actually glow like a light bulb? No, that's not possible! So, then, how are we a light? When we follow Jesus He lives in us and His Spirit helps us to do good things. Jesus tells us to love each other and to be kind and to obey His Word and to be helpful and lots of other good things. When you do these good things, that is Jesus' way of showing you how to shine. When you do the good things, people will wonder what makes you want to do the good things. You tell them that Jesus makes you that way.

Let's pray:

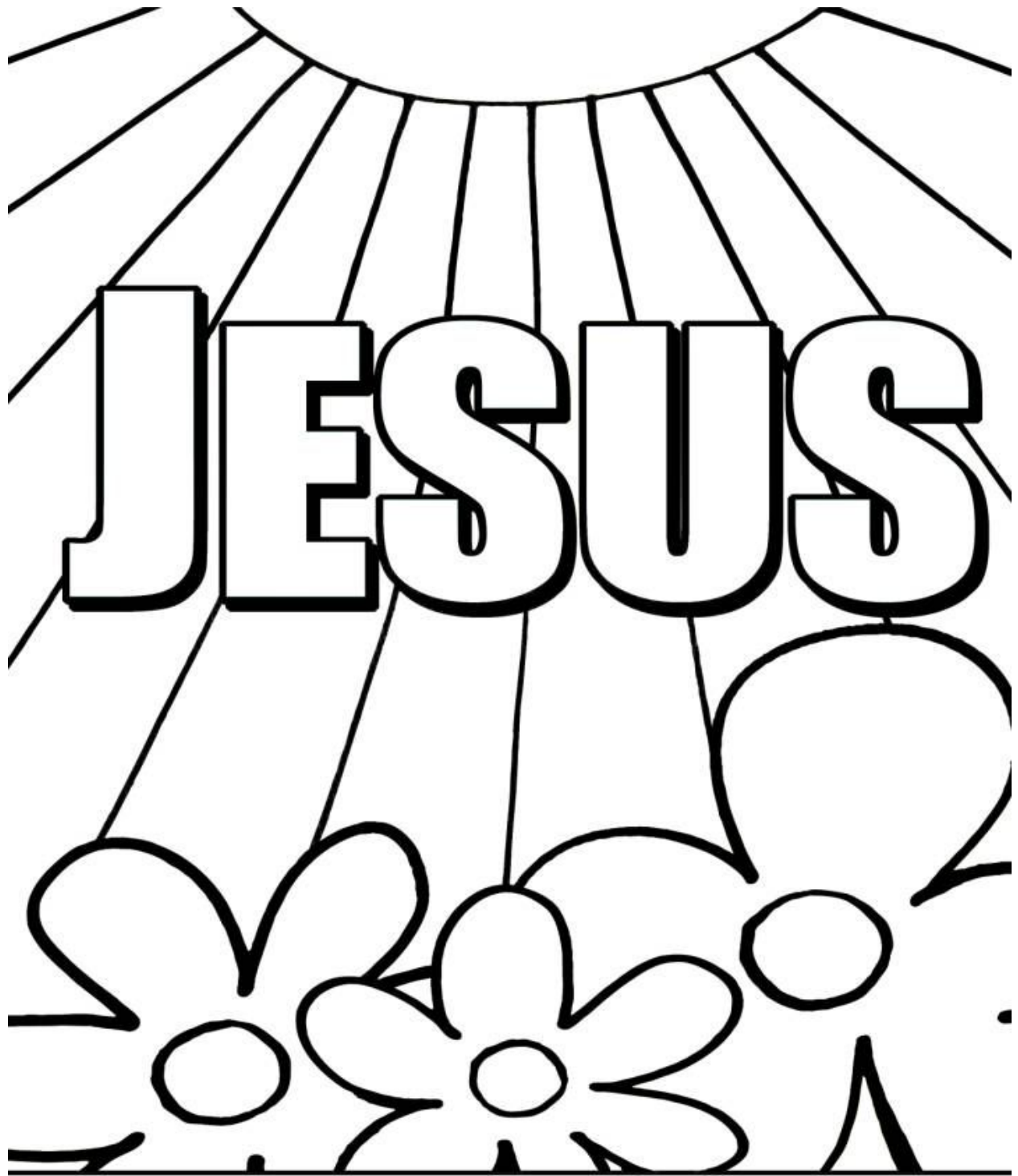

## **ACTIVITIES:**

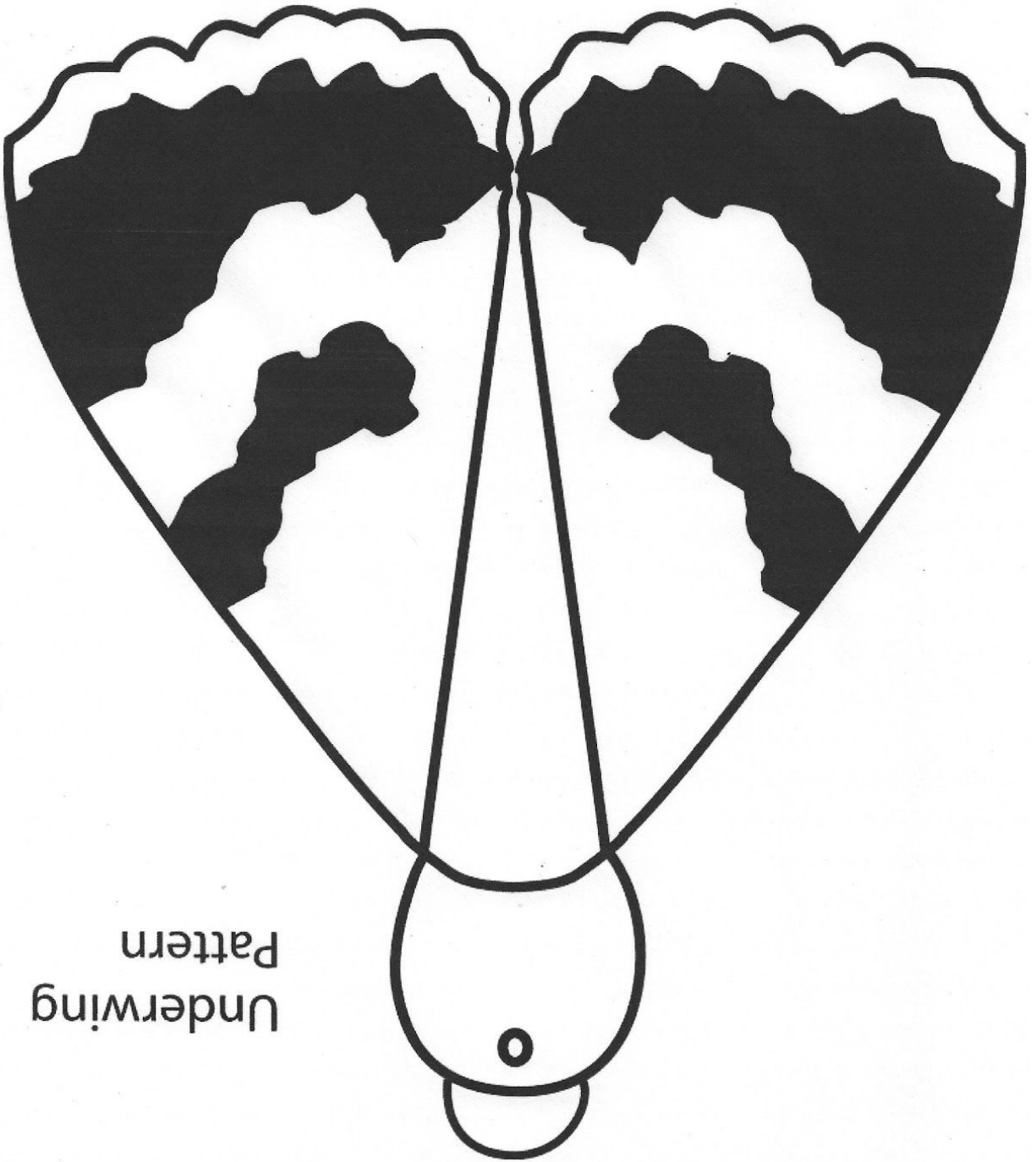

\*Play flashlight tag at night and while you play, talk about Jesus being our light and how we can be a light to the world.

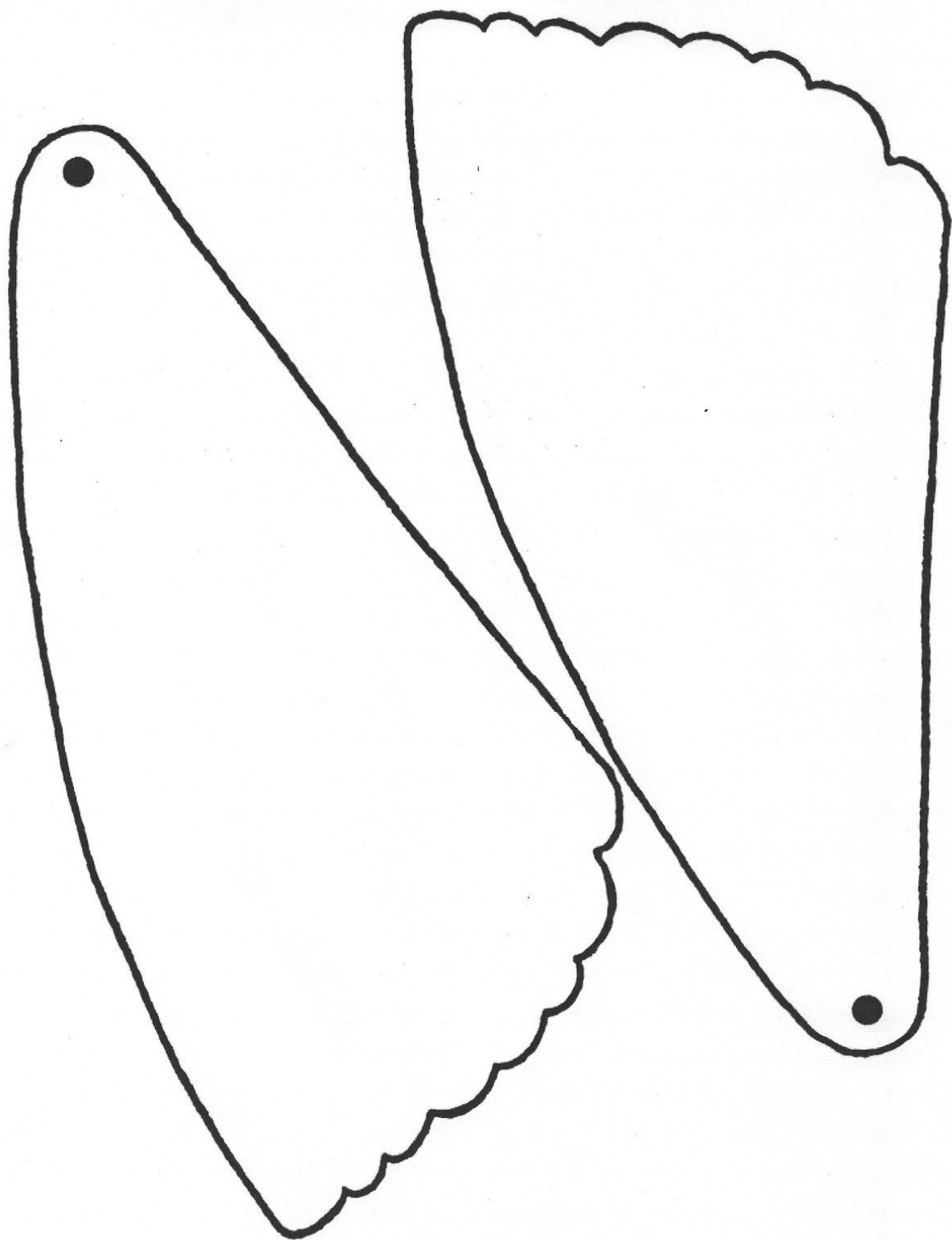

Happy August Immanuel Friends!!!

Wait, it's August already! That means my kids will be leaving me to go away to college very, very soon. I know my daughter is very excited to get back to her college friends. She can't wait!!! This will be my son's first year away at school, so he doesn't mind the wait. To one person the wait can seem very long, but to others not so long. It all depends on what you are waiting for. I know you must hear your parents say, "be patient". We can all be impatient, depending on what it is we are waiting upon. Our fruit of the Spirit lesson today is on \_\_\_\_? I am not going to say because you know it.

Let's start with our verse. I am going to leave blanks and I want you to fill them in. Our verse is found in the book of \_\_\_\_\_ chapter 5 verses 22-23.

"But the fruit of the \_\_\_\_\_ is love, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and \_\_\_\_\_. Against such things there is no law."

What is patience?

According to one dictionary, patience is defined as the quality of waiting calmly without complaining. Another dictionary defines patience as the ability to calmly put up with pain or trouble without getting upset or angry. So, according to these definitions, patience is not just the ability to wait on something, but it is waiting with a good attitude. It is the ability to be happy and considerate even though things are difficult or frustrating. It means you don't lose control when things get hard. When you show patience you are showing that you respect others and yourself. According to those definitions, I guess I am not always a patient person!! Patience is something both kids and adults need to continuously work on.

We live in a very fast paced world of microwaves, cell phones and one day shipping. Our world wants things speedy!! People keep developing new technology to keep up with the fast pace. God, however, is not obsessed with time like His children are. Our minds are constantly racing with what we have to do next or what we want to do next. We are always in a hurry. God wants us to slow down and enjoy all of the things He has planned for us.

Sometimes we struggle to be patient with people in our lives. During these times, we should remember God's patience toward us. As sinners, we have offended God. So, God has every right to be angry with us, but instead, He showed us just how wonderful His patience is by saving us! If someone hurts you, and you really just want to hurt them back any way you can, whether it be yelling and screaming at them, hitting them, pushing them, ignoring them, etc, think of all the things you have done against God. Think about how He could have punished you, but instead, in His patience, He poured out His mercy and love. This is not just when we were saved either. Everyday we still do things against God and He is patient with us. Hopefully that truth will sink deep into your heart and motivate you to be more patient with those around you.

In order to know all about patience, where should we look? Yes, the Bible. God's Word is the ultimate source of all truth! There are many stories in the Bible on people who waited on God and His timing. The one we are going to look at today is Abram and Sarah. It is found in the book of Genesis. What part of the Bible is the book of Genesis in? Yes, it is the first book in the Old Testament.

*"When Abram was ninety-nine years old, the Lord appeared to him and said, 'I am God Almighty; walk before me and be blameless. I will confirm my covenant between me and you, and will greatly increase your numbers.' Abram fell facedown, and God said to him, 'As for me, this is my covenant with you: You will be the father of a many nations. No longer will you be called Abram; your name will be Abraham, for I have made you a father of many nations. I will make you very fruitful; I will make nations of you, and kings will come from you.' . . . Abraham fell facedown; he laughed and said to himself, 'Will a son be born to a man who is a hundred years old? Will Sarah bear a child at the age of ninety?'"* Genesis 17:1-6; 17

Sometimes God asks us to wait for something even though He's promised it to us. God promised Abraham he would be the father of many people. But at a very old age, he was still without any children. Abraham and Sarah knew what God had told them, but they had yet to see evidence of the promise in their lives. How could Abraham become the father of many when he didn't have any children? Abraham and Sarah trusted God and they waited patiently for him. This doesn't mean they waited perfectly. They took matters into their own hands at times. But God's grace covered them and he still fulfilled his promise, in his perfect timing.

Sometimes God, and our parents, ask us to wait for things. We have to trust that they know what is best for us and will do what they promised. As we wait, it is tempting to make things happen on our own or to run ahead. But waiting patiently means waiting without question or complaining. Each day we will face situations that are going to test our patience. Whether they are small things, or big things, remember to turn to the Lord to help you in the waiting.

Below are some situations that may call for us to practice our patience:

- \* I can wait patiently for my turn, without asking over and over when it will be my turn.
- \* I can wait patiently for the teacher to call on me when I have my hand up, without making loud noises or waving my hand back and forth to get attention.
- \* I can wait patiently for someone to finish with the glue, scissors, or other craft supplies, without trying to rush them to finish.
- \* I can wait patiently while Mom cooks dinner, without asking her over and over if it is ready yet.
- \* I can wait patiently while others take their turns at the water fountain, without trying to get them to hurry up.
- \* I can be patient with myself when I am trying to learn something new without getting mad or frustrated and giving up too soon, or complaining that it is too hard and I can't do it.
- \* I can be patient with my younger brothers or sisters, realizing that they take more time to do things than I do. I will not get mad or pushy when I have to wait on them, but instead show them nicely how to do something and wait patiently while they learn to do it themselves.
- \* I can wait patiently when I want something really bad and my parents tell me that I can't have it right now, knowing that I should be happy with what I have now.
- \* I can be patient with my brother or sister when they bug me. Instead of getting angry or upset, I can calmly ask them to stop doing what is bugging me or realize that they can't help it.

Patience is one of the fruits of the Spirit that helps other fruit to grow in our lives. It sometimes means not getting angry when we don't get our own way. It sometimes means not getting irritated and annoyed when we have to wait for something. True patience is a gift from God - a fruit of the Holy Spirit. That means it is good to pray to God to help us be more patient and also trust Him to allow His truth to continue to grow in our lives.

Let's pray:

Father God, thank you for your great patience towards me when I make mistakes. Please forgive me for my impatience towards those around me. I ask that You would help me have patience with the everyday things and people before me. Help me to wait on your timing in all things, and keep me from complaining or becoming angry while I wait. Thank you for showing me Your love and help me to show that same love towards others so people will see Jesus in my life. In Jesus' name. Amen

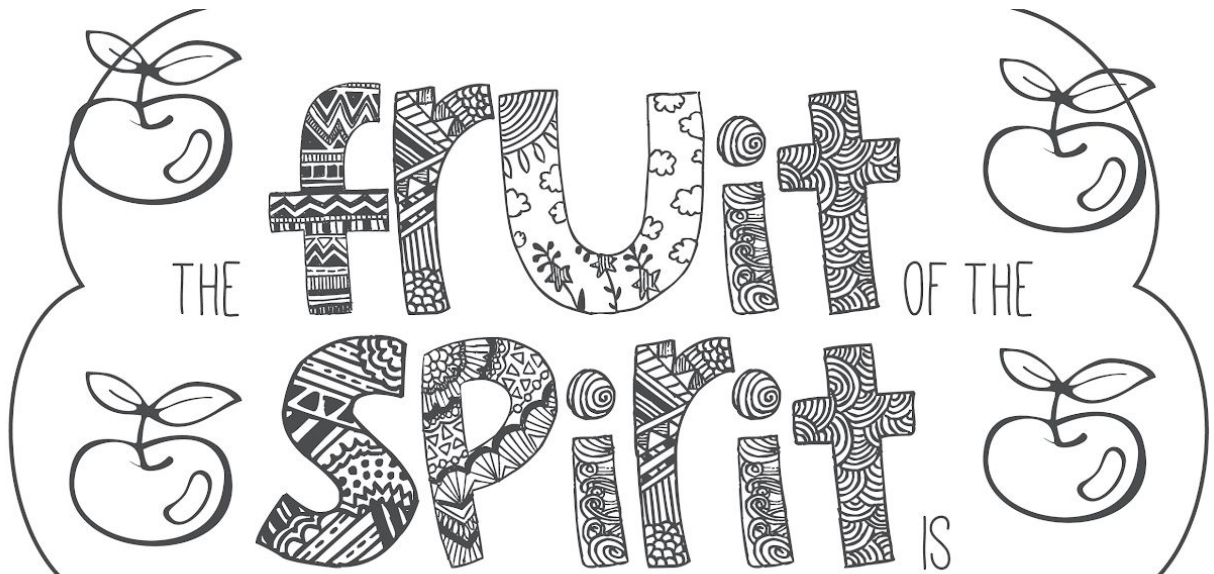
