

And we are encouraging other opportunities for safe gatherings for small group Bible studies, fellowship and service.

Back to our trip! I said it was emotional. Vicki and I were honored to be included on the bucket list of people to whom our dear friend (of almost forty years who is now bravely facing her terminal illness) wished to spend time with and say goodbye. I am so thankful for the time we had with her and her husband sharing the bitter-sweet days together with an eternal perspective. We then traveled to the home of Vicki's mom and stepdad, where he was recovering from hip surgery and discussed the need for them to move to a more compatible home for this stage in life. A difficult discussion in the setting of a house built as a dream home by the lake, but it was received in love and appreciation, and transition plans began to take place. Then we traveled to the house built by my dad where I grew up. Mom has had a hard time selling it, but she finally agreed it was best, and by the middle of this month it will no longer be the "Bearden House." Tears filled my eyes as I went back into Dad's shop one last time. Vicki had noticed a tool hanging on the wall partially covered by an old jacket Dad kept handy and asked if I wanted it. I did, but my hand hesitated to move Dad's coat and remove it from the hook.

We had spent the night before at my cousin's house in Little Rock. We had stayed up late talking of childhood memories and our parents. His mom, Dad's sister, now in a senior facility, and my father now gone, both left such a legacy of Christian service and family values. Many of those memories were connected to that old house and the woods surrounding it during our childhood. Included in those memories were multiple times Dad had dealt with our not putting his tools back after using them. Something about that tarnished crescent wrench hanging right by the door frame for handy use was exactly where it needed to be. And yet, there are few things my mechanic dad would like better than to know his son would put it back into useful service.
