Discussion/Study Guide for Colossians 2:6-7
Aug. 9, 2020
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Discussion Questions:

Being rooted:

- Think of something that has happened in the past week that got an emotional response from you.
 - Describe what happened and what emotions it caused within you.
 - Why did you feel that emotion? Is that reason rooted in who you understand the person of Jesus to be, or is it rooted in something else?

Being built up:

- Reflect on the past few months of your life.
 - What has been most challenging to you?
 - What is the greatest area of development you have seen in your relationship with God?

Being established:

- What “storm” are you going through right now?
 - On a scale of 1-10, 1 being firm and 10 being hard (and 0 being uprooted), where would you place yourself as you face this storm?
 - What is God, through His word and through those who share the name of Jesus, establishing in you through this storm?

Overflowing:

- What is overflowing from you?
 - Thankfulness, joy, peace, weariness, anxiety, fear, anger, or something else? It might help to think of a common thought or phrase that has repeatedly come to your mind this past week.
 - How have you seen God’s grace and love at work that you can give thanks for?

Walking in Christ:

- When someone hears the name of Jesus, what do you hope they would think of?
 - What is one action you can take this week to represent that image of Jesus to others?
