"Rooted, Growing, and Reaching"

As I am sure it is for everyone, my plans are not exactly working out on the schedule I had planned. And this is true for the big plans we had for the Graham Street Church in 2020. From the time I moved here and began working with the Elders, we have been working on a 2020 Vision. Sounded catchy, didn't it? We had a pretty solid approach, I thought, based on a pretty simple outline for the mission of the church, to be "Rooted, Growing and Reaching." Rooted in Christ and His Word. Growing into Christ to become like Christ. Reaching Up to God, In to our church family, and Out to the world. We spent the first year in review of what we know, were, and did. We worked on our roots. We studied God's Story in an overview of the whole Bible, we evaluated our ministries and developed strategies for improvement. The second year we continued to work on our roots as we studied our core beliefs through the "Believe" Bible Study series, but we began to apply greater emphasis on strengthening our focus on maturing the church family. The third year we continued efforts to mature by focusing on reaching out through serving love in mission. We were getting excited about sharing a clear vision forward in 2020. But all things did not go as planned, and major changes had to be made!

We had planned a relaunch of our small group ministry, doing more with family ministry, to have even greater outreach in the community and in mission efforts, and to finish our building remodel with an overflowing capacity Friend's Day! None of this happened as we thought it would in 2020. But maybe it can happen through God's vision for us in ways we didn't plan. COVID has forced us to see the value of small groups meeting in homes, and redirected our attention on family and meeting the needs of our community in a better way than we would have consider if we were not dealing with the virus. Our changes in staffing, ministry leadership, and the demands on shepherding the church family has given rise to better strategic thinking and planning with new leaders stepping out in faith. A worldwide pandemic has made us think beyond ourselves and revise our vision for mission and deepen our commitment and charity to those most in need. Our being forced to figure our new ways to conduct Bible Classes and worship, fellowship with one another, and provide spiritual resources for families, parents, teens and children has deepened the meaning of "Rooted, Growing, and Reaching." I encourage all our members to pay close attention to how God is helping us use what seems an obstacle to our church mission as an opportunity to accomplish more than we had planned.
