Hi Immanuel Kids,

I just want to start out by letting you know this will be the last week we will be looking at bugs and insects found in God's wonderful world. Now, can you tell me what the bug is in the pictures below?





They are stink bugs. Did you guess it correctly? I wasn't sure how familiar you would be with these bugs. Stink bug is a silly sounding name isn't it? Do you know why this bug is called a stink bug? If someone bothers the bug, moves the bug, hurts it or crushes it, it gives off a very bad, stinky smell. The smell comes from glands by the bugs legs that produce a stinky, bad tasting chemical. The bug uses this chemical to protect themselves from predators and people

who want to harm them. Both the green and the brown stink bugs are considered pests because they damage fruit and plants. They cause harm to crops such as apples, corn, peaches, and tomatoes. This costs farmers money because when the fruit and vegetables are destroyed the farmers can't sell it and make money.

What do stink bugs have to do with us you may be asking? Well, sometimes people have stinky attitudes. Kids can have stinky attitudes and grown ups can have stinky attitudes too. What is a stinky attitude? What is a godly (right) attitude? If we are going to have the right attitude, we need to be able to tell the difference, right? So, I am going to give you a few examples. If what I am saying is a godly, right attitude, I want you to say "woo hoo". If what I am saying is a bad attitude, I want you to say "pee-yew". Got it? Okay, let's start.

*You really want candy, so you ask your mom, "Mom, can I have candy?" But your mom says no. You do not like what your mom says so you start yelling and crying and having a temper tantrum. What do you think? Godly attitude or stinky attitude? You got it! Pee-yew, it is a stinky attitude. Did you say pee-yew? We should not argue with our parents or complain when we don't like what they have to say. That is not what Jesus would have done.

Let's try another one


*You are playing with your friend and your friend accidentally knocks you down and you were hurt. You know your friend didn't mean to do it, and you say to your friend, "That's okay I forgive you." Is that a stinky attitude or a godly attitude? Woo hoo, that's right! It is a godly attitude. Your friend didn't mean to hurt you. In the Bible it tells us that we are to forgive others who hurt us. Even if it wasn't an accident, Jesus tells us to always forgive others.

Here's one more


*Your mom asks you to clean up your toys because it is time for bed. You don't want to clean up and you whine to your mom that you are still playing. You don't listen to your mom and you continue playing with the toys. Is that a stinky or godly attitude? Pee-yew stinky! Even if you didn't yell and throw a temper tantrum, it is still stinky because you are being disobedient. Jesus tells us that we need to listen to the adults in our lives and do what they tell us. Jesus always did the right thing and made the right choice. We want to do what Jesus does.

We need to remember that having the right attitude is a choice we make. You can choose to have a stinky attitude if you are mad, or you can choose to have a godly attitude like Jesus. I hope you make the right choices when your mommy or daddy or teachers tell you what to do.

Let's pray: Dear God, thank you for the Bible which teaches us about having the right, godly attitude like Jesus. Help me choose to have a godly attitude so I am not like the stink bug. In Jesus' name. Amen

Good morning Immanuel Kids,

Can you believe it is almost time for school to begin?! I was taking a walk with my little kids the other day and couldn't believe how many trees were already starting to change colors!! I love God's creativity in the seasons! Also, can you believe that the Children's Church program is starting up again. What exciting times!

Now, on to our lesson. You do have our verse memorized by now, right? Are you shaking your head yes for me. I can hear many of your heads rattling around!! First I want you to close your eyes and say the verse out loud. Go ahead and do that, and then we will read the verse together.

Galatians 5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law."

Remember, when we put our faith in Jesus, we received an amazing gift from God in the form of the Holy Spirit. As the Spirit leads us, we grow and start to bear fruit. It is a way of saying that we are becoming more like Jesus. We can't produce good fruits in us on our own. We need the help of the Holy Spirit to produce these fruits (behaviors/attitudes).

We are on the 8th fruit which is gentleness. What does it mean to be gentle? A humble and meek attitude; a mild, kind, or tender character; being soothing or calm - yes, all these things. Someone who displays gentleness wants to help other people instead of wanting to be superior to them. This attitude flows from a spirit of real love for the individual. It is having a real concern for the well being of others.

Let's read from the book of Samuel. Which part of the Bible can you find Samuel? Yes, the Old Testament!

2 Samuel 22:36 "You have given me the shield of your salvation, and your gentleness has made me great."

This verse is from a song David sang after God delivered him from his enemies. First we see that God is powerful in defeating David's enemies, and then it describes God as being gentle. Describing God this way does not mean He is not powerful. David faced a great deal of dangers in his life, but God was always there, caring, protecting, and guiding him. When David says God's gentleness made him great, he is referring to the constant care over his life.

Now let's read Matthew 21:5 together. "Say to the Daughter of Zion, 'See your king comes to you, gentle and riding on a donkey...' "

Who do you think this verse is talking about? That's right! The prophet Zachariah wrote this about Jesus. He described Jesus as gentle. So, even though we know Jesus is strong and powerful, He was described as gentle.

Now we will look at an example of gentleness found in Acts 17:16-34. It is a long passage that I will not type out, but you can read it by yourself or with your mom, dad, grandma, etc. and then you can continue reading the lesson.

When Paul began his message to the Athenians, he took into account the background and situation of the people with their many gods. He started out by noting how they were very religious, and then proceeded to comment on one altar he had seen with the inscription 'To An Unknown God'. He said, "Now what you worship as something unknown I am going to proclaim to you." (Acts 17:23)

This was a gentle way of easing people out of the idea of dozens of gods and into the idea of one true God. Even though some mocked, others asked to hear more, and some even joined and believed.

How do you think Paul would have been received if he hadn't spoken with gentleness? Imagine if he said, "Men of Athens!! You have sinned greatly with all your many gods!! You are ignorant about anything religious!! You are foolish people!" Would anyone have wanted to listen to him? Probably not. Here, Paul proved Proverbs 15:1, which states - "A soft answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger."

Just like all Fruits of the Spirit, the perfect example of gentleness is Jesus. Let's look at the story found in John 8:1-11.


One day, Jesus was sitting in the temple courtyard teaching a group of people. Some Pharisees and other leaders marched in with a woman who had been caught sinning. The leaders did not care about the woman. They were testing Jesus to see if He would follow the Law. The Law said they were allowed to throw stones at the woman to punish her. "What do you say?" they asked Jesus. But Jesus bent down on the ground to write with his finger. They kept asking him questions. So he stood up and said to them, "If any of you is without sin, let him be the first to throw a stone at her." (John 8:7) He bent down again and wrote on the ground. Those who heard what he had said began to go away. Soon only Jesus and the woman were left. Jesus stood up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you.? "No one, sir," she said. "Then neither do I condemn you," Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin." (John 8:10-11)


Wow! Wasn't that a beautiful, gentle answer! Jesus didn't scold the Pharisees. He didn't yell at the woman because of her sin. He was gentle with both. Jesus had a right to be harsh, but He gave a gentle answer, and His gentle answer changed all of their hearts!

If Jesus' gentle Spirit lives in us, then how should we speak to other people? Gently! No matter who we are talking to, we should use gentle speech.

Think about your behavior last week. Were you gentle in the situations you faced? If not, why? In general, would people describe you as gentle? Do you exhibit the same gentleness to others that God exhibits to you every day?

Let's pray: Dear Lord, thank you that you love us so much that you gently lead us and guide us. Thank you for helping us be gentle in the way we deal with others. Please help us to continue to learn from you, Jesus, so that we can be more and more like you. In Jesus' name. Amen
