

Over the next 40 days prior to our revival we want to spend a significant amount of time in prayer seeking God's face and favor for our families and our church. This guide is intended to help you focus on specific needs throughout the week.

As we go throughout this time of prayer, we are going to pray big picture strategic prayers for our congregation and the community that God has given us to reach for him. We believe that God wants to work some major spiritual breakthroughs through our church as we ask God to fulfill his redemptive plan of the ages and help us accomplish our part in it.

We know that there are over 20,000 souls living within a five-mile radius of our church property. These are the people that Jesus has called us to reach with the Gospel. At times, it even seems impossible but Jesus said that if we ask anything in his name, according to his will, IT WILL BE DONE! I happen to believe that our vision is in His name and according to His will and that over the next several months we will see God do even greater things than these simply because we made prayer our first priority!

The writer of Hebrews said, **"since we have confidence to enter the holy places by the blood of Jesus... let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith."** If Jesus Christ has opened wide the throne room of God with his blood, let's get in there and make something happen through prayer! The eternal destination of men, women, and children hangs in the balance!

Pray for core ministries of First Church

Prepare your heart and mind

As you prepare your heart and mind for prayer, remember that God is our wonderful Father who longs to hear from us and is waiting to meet our needs and grant our requests!

Matthew 7:7-11 "Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. ⁸ For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. ⁹ Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰ Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? ¹¹ If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!"

Begin with God as the central theme

"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name."

When we begin prayer with worship our perspective changes, our faith increases, our anxiety melts away, and our prayer requests are transformed into the mind and heartbeat of Jesus himself!

As you go to prayer, read through the following scriptures...

- Read slowly, thoughtfully, and prayerfully.
- Take time to ponder each verse thoroughly, making it your own.
- Then pray it back to God before moving on to the next verse.

Begin with a foundation of praise and adoration based on the greatness of God

Psalms 145

¹ I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever.

² Every day I will bless you and praise your name forever and ever.

³ Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and his greatness is unsearchable.

⁴ One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.

⁵ On the glorious splendor of your majesty, and on your wondrous works, I will meditate.

⁶ They shall speak of the might of your awesome deeds, and I will declare your greatness.

⁷ They shall pour forth the fame of your abundant goodness and shall sing aloud of your righteousness.

⁸ The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.

⁹ The Lord is good to all, and his mercy is over all that he has made. ¹⁰ All your works shall give thanks to you, O Lord, and all your saints shall bless you!

¹¹ They shall speak of the glory of your kingdom and tell of your power, ¹² to make known to the children of man your mighty deeds, and the glorious splendor of your kingdom.

¹³ Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures throughout all generations. [The Lord is faithful in all his words and kind in all his works.]

Pray for the spiritual vitality of one another

Ephesians 3:14-21 "For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, ¹⁵ from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, ¹⁶ that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷ so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith—that you, being rooted and grounded in love, ¹⁸ may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth¹⁹ and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰ Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen."

Pray for key outreach ministries

Daniel 9:3-7, 9-10, 14, 16-19 I turned my face to the Lord God, seeking him by prayer and pleas for mercy with fasting and sackcloth and ashes. ⁴ I praved to the Lord my God and made confession, saying, "O Lord, the great and awesome God, who keeps covenant and steadfast love with those who love him and keep his commandments, ⁵ we have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, turning aside from your commandments and rules. ⁶We have not listened to your servants the prophets, who spoke in your name to our kings, our princes, and our fathers, and to all the people of the land. ⁷ To you, O Lord, belongs righteousness, but to us open shame, ⁹ To the Lord our God belong mercy and forgiveness, for we have rebelled against him ¹⁰ and have not obeyed the voice of the Lord our God by walking in his laws, which he set before us by his servants the prophets. ¹⁴ Therefore the Lord has kept ready the calamity and has brought it upon us, for the Lord our God is righteous in all the works that he has done, and we have not obeyed his voice. ¹⁶ "O Lord, according to all your righteous acts, let your anger and your wrath turn away from your city Jerusalem, your holy hill, because for our sins, and for the iniquities of our fathers, Jerusalem and your people have become a byword among all who are around us. ¹⁷ Now therefore, O our God, listen to the prayer of your servant and to his pleas for mercy, and for your own sake, O Lord, make your face to shine upon your sanctuary, which is desolate. ¹⁸ O my God, incline your ear and hear. Open your eyes and see our desolations, and the city that is called by your name. For we do not present our pleas before you because of our righteousness, but because of your great mercy. ¹⁹ O Lord, hear; O Lord, forgive. O Lord, pay attention and act. Delay not, for your own sake, O my God, because your city and your people are called by your name."
