1:3-10

How had Paul presented the gospel to his audience? (1:5-6)

How had the Thessalonians responded to the gospel message? (1:6-7)

Whom did the Thessalonians imitate? (1:6)

Reflection: For whom do you hope you are providing an example and model for living the Christian life? Ask God to help you set an example.

Describe the results of what happened to the Thessalonians upon being converted. (1:7-10)
