Want to Study?

While students are adjusting to back to school study, churches are trying to make adjustments to get back to Bible Classes in their buildings. Graham Street Church is no exception. We are preparing for going back to Sunday School this Sunday, September 13. But it will be different! Because of our need to continue to practice social distancing and wearing masks in crowds, we need to continue to have two worship services on Sunday mornings. This makes it difficult to have our Sunday morning Bible Classes. It is still difficult to know that we can consistently provide the teachers needed for the age divided classes, so we have had to make adjustments.

We have moved our Sunday School program to Sunday night at 5:00 during this period of adjustment with the hope that we will be able to go back to Sunday morning Bible Classes soon. We will start by offering 3 Bible Classes: an Adult Bible Class in the auditorium, first taught by Hughbert concluding the Acts class he started before the COVID-19 suspension, and then Mike Dacus will teach the books of 1 & 2 Peter; a Family Bible Class taught by a group of teachers for pre-teen children and their parents in the Family Center; and Wes will offer a class for the teens in Room 109.

In addition to these Sunday evening classes, we are offering Bible Classes at other times. Le Jones is teaching a class on the book of Revelation in the Family Center on Thursday nights. Wes will be offering a monthly opportunity for the Youth Ministry to get together in the Family Center on Wednesday nights starting in October. Several of our small groups are meeting on Sunday afternoon or during the week. I will be offering a Wednesday night class at 6:30 in the auditorium Sept. 23 and 30 that I am calling, "A Responsible Christian Voter" – it is not to tell you how to vote, but how to be engaged in our political process with Christian character.

These classes are just the beginning of what we hope to offer in the future for fellowship, activities and Bible Classes, but we will be flexible for the health and safety of our church members and the community. In all these classes we encourage adherence to the COVID guidelines for building use found on the next page of this bulletin.

COVID Guidelines for Building Use

We encourage our members to make use of our facilities for Bible study, fellowship, worship and spiritual formation, but we encourage you to do it safely. We want the Graham Street Church of Christ to be responsible and do our part to slow the spread of the Corona Virus. Please do not attend if you are showing symptoms of a contagious illness, such as elevated temperature, runny nose, sore throat, cough, etc. We ask everyone entering and exiting the Main Building or Family Center to wear a face covering and practice social distancing. Once inside and seated with your family with six feet of separation from other individuals or families you may remove your mask if you wish as long as you remain in this space. You are asked to wear a face covering should you need to leave your seating area and move around the room. Everyone is also expected to thoroughly wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer. We will limit seating to 50% of occupancy, and individuals entering after we have reached this level should sit in the overflow area. By reserving any of the Graham Street Church of Christ facilities you are accepting responsibility for these guidelines. Your cooperation is appreciated as a show of your care and concern for the most at risk in the compassion of Christ.
