Activity #1

PASS IT AROUND

Directions: Have your group (family) sit in a circle. Choose one person to sit in the middle and wear the blindfold. Pass the roll and the cup separately around the circle while everyone sings “Jesus Loves Me, This I Know” one time. When the song is over, everyone places their hands behind their back. The person in the middle can remove the blindfold and have guess who is holding the roll and who is holding the cup.

Say: In our Bible story today, Jesus passed the bread and cup to His disciples. The bread and cup helped the disciples remember how Jesus died for them so they could be forgiven for the bad things they did. But did Jesus stay in His grave? No way! Jesus died and now He’s alive!

Question: Jesus wants us to remember Him. What are some things you remember about Jesus?

Activity #2

OLD BECOMES NEW

Lesson Review: Our next activity is an example of something old becoming new - Jesus does for us! When we sin, we have little dirt on us, but since Jesus sacrificed His body and shed His blood for us, we can be clean. All we have to do is follow Him!

Directions:

- Pour the salt into the white vinegar.
- Stir the mixture until the salt is partially dissolved (you may need paper towels).
- Show the group the new, shiny penny and an old, dirty one.

ACTIVITY #2

- Tell the group that the pennies remind us what sin does to our lives.
 - The new penny is how God created us—perfect and without any blemishes.
 - The old penny is what sin does to us—it covers us in darkness.
- Put the dirty penny in the vinegar/salt mixture
- Slowly count down from 10.
- Take the penny out.
- Rinse and rub the penny clean under running water.

- **Question:** What can we do as a group to remember Jesus?
