

{From the Pastor's Pen} Matt Jackson God the Judge Matthew 25:31-41



September 20, 2020

Dear Church Family,

As we continue to learn about God and how to "Know God" better, we approach a touchy subject this Sunday! Pastor Mark taught us about the God of Grace last week of which, even as I sit here, I can't stop trying to comprehend! What a great and gracious God we serve! So then as we continue to peel back the attributes of God and see Him for everything He is, we must address God the Judge.

The word judge or judgment seems to carry so many fearful or negative connotations for us today. Unfortunately, nothing could be further from the truth. As we examine who God is, we will quickly realize that judgment is a necessary part of who God is and that it points to His love, grace, and justice. Can you imagine a world where people shout out, "It's not fair!" without any point of reference or comparison to what is actually fair? Without a fair and just judge, we would live in a land of chaos and disorder. Nothing would be fair because we would have no point of reference to what is actually fair!

God is the ultimate standard of morality, justice, and even perfection. Although we can't match up to what is required to live sinless lives, God impressed these things on our hearts to know what is right and wrong. When we accept Christ into our lives, not only do we realize the difference between what is right and wrong, but we also are convicted to make it right and repent to God daily. Our message this week is not just about the God the Judge, but also about the "mediator" who stands in the place of those who have accepted Christ as their Savior. Yes...Christ himself!

The seriousness of judgment is found everywhere in scripture. Even in preparing this message, I was dumbfounded to be reminded of how much scripture talks about judgment. From the Old Testament to the last book of the New Testament, we see stories of judgment: judgment carried out and judgment to come. The seriousness of the subject and this part of the character of God cannot be overlooked when in fact God sent prophet after prophet to warn people of upcoming judgment whether in this life or in the one to come in eternity. Paul talks about the seriousness of judgment in the New Testament and it even intensifies as we read Revelation. Regardless if you believe we are in the end times, if we are experiencing "birth pains" of the end, or we are just seeing a fallen world that is living in disregard to scripture, we still have a job

to do! We must point people to the grace and love of Jesus so that we will all stand in confidence knowing that Jesus will stand in our place on judgment day and we don't have a thing to worry about!

Thank you for being the church! We have a mighty task in front of us, but we serve a Mighty God who can handle it all!
