Good morning Immanuel Kids,

Did you know this is the last weekend for summer? Fall, or Autumn, starts on Tuesday!! I love the crisp air and the beautiful colors of the leaves we see in the Fall!! Do you know what else I love? The silly pictures below. Look at the pictures of the cats hiding. Aren't they silly?!!



Do you like to play hiding games? Maybe you like to play hide and seek. You have to be very quiet and sneaky when you hide from someone, don't you? Hiding can be fun, but in the story we are going to read today, there was a man who had to hide, but it wasn't a game. The man in our story was hiding because he was afraid. In what book do you think we are going to find today's story? Yes, of course, the Bible. Our story is in the book of Judges. You can read the story from your own Bible, or read it below.

(Moms and dads - you could tell this story inside a "Cave"- blankets and table- and pretend to be hiding from the Midianites)

Our story is about a man named Gideon. Gideon was a good guy and he was hiding in a pit because he didn't want the mean men of Midian to find out what he was doing. (He was threshing wheat so he could make flour to make some bread.) Everyone was afraid of the mean men of

Midian. They were big, bad bullies. They would come by the thousands into Gideon's land and take whatever they wanted. Good guy Gideon knew that if the mean men of Midian saw him threshing his wheat, they would take it from him, and he wouldn't have anything to feed his family.



Good guy Gideon was hard at work threshing his wheat and trying to be as quiet as he could when all of a sudden he heard a voice. It said, "The Lord is with you, brave and mighty man." Gideon almost jumped out of his sandals. He thought he was alone. He looked around and saw something that looked like an angel. He couldn't believe his eyes.

Good guy Gideon thought to himself, "Is this really an angel and why would an angel come and talk to me? And why would he say the Lord is with me? Me, a brave and mighty man? He has to be kidding."

Good guy Gideon asked the angel. "If God is with me, why has all this stuff happened to me and my family? God saved my people from Pharaoh and brought them to the Promised Land, but now he has left us. Why isn't God helping us now? We have to hide out in caves and live like animals. Where is God now?"

The angel said, "God wants you to go and save your people from the mean men of Midian."

Good guy Gideon was shocked. He said, "Who, me? Couldn't be. Why would God send me? My family is the weakest in all the land and I am the weakest in my whole family."

Then the angel said, "Yes, you. God will be with you and you will win against the mean men of Midian." Gideon wasn't so sure about that, but he obeyed God and did everything God told him to do.

Not long after that the mean men of Midian camped out in a Valley not too far from where Gideon lived. The power of God came on Gideon. He knew it was time to drive out all the mean men of Midian. Gideon blew his trumpet and called all the people together to fight against them.



Over thirty-two thousand men showed up to help good guy Gideon drive out the mean men of Midian.

WOW!! That is a lot of men! I wonder what happens next. You will have to wait until next week to hear the rest of the story of good guy Gideon and how he became a great warrior.


Now I want to ask you some questions. Do you ever feel scared like Gideon and want to go and hide? Do you feel like you are too little to do anything for God?

God is with us and He will give us the strength and power we need to face our problems.
