2019 ANNUAL REPORTS—The deadline for submitting annual reports for 2019 is today. If you haven't done so already, please submit your report to Ruth Pirinelli. Thank you for your service to the congregation in 2019!

A SPECIAL CONGREGATIONAL MEETING will be held today. There is no Sunday School today to allow all members to attend this meeting. This special meeting is being called at the request of 18 members who have signed a petition, and this request has been done in accordance with our Church constitution. The main purpose of the meeting will be to revisit the TV Monitor - Projection vote and decision as it is felt by the petitioners that there was not a large enough representation of the congregation at the Monday night meeting this summer when the decision was made to proceed with TV monitors. The petitioners feel that we will have a larger number of members participate if we have this meeting following a single service on a Sunday morning, and the petition has specifically asked for the meeting to be scheduled in this way. Council discussed the timing request and feels that it is in the best interest of the congregation to honor this requested approach for this special meeting. Council is asking all members to make your best effort to attend this one service and meeting so everyone's input can be taken into account. The specific meeting agenda items requested by the petition are as follows:

- 1. The use of video or not
- 2. Type of video (TV monitor wall mounted vs. projection)
- 3. Placement of equipment (one or both sides of the front of church, including ceiling if projection is preferred)
- 4. Alternate Sunday use
- Requiring that any and all annual or semi-annual congrega-5. tional meetings be held on a one-service Sunday

Since this decision will be revisited, Council is suspending fund raising for the TV monitors. As of Sunday, November 10, we have raised approximately \$5,700 toward this project. We have also been working on planning its implementation and have a new estimate of \$6,000 to complete the project as currently directed by the previous meeting vote. If the decision changes and you have donated to the TV monitors, you will be given the opportunity to redirect your donation or to be refunded.
