PASTOR'S RETURN FROM LAOS—Thanks be to God, Pastor and his family returned home safely and healthy from Laos Thursday night! They have cleared all screenings and health assessments and the Health Department has cleared them for normal activity. Pastor and his family are not required to stay at home. Pastor is anxious to get back to work. However, he understands the level of concern with Coronavirus that people have and wants everyone to be comfortable. We found information on the CDC's website this weekend indicating no restrictions for people that did not leave a Chinese airport. We are going to try and contact CDC verbally this coming week to verify that we are understanding their recommendations correctly. If this is verified, then we will still be taking some extra precautions above and beyond CDC and Health Department regulations, and Pastor and his family will be staying away from church and school this coming week. Pastor will be returning next Sunday to lead our service. Again, this is voluntary and being done for all of you, even though not required by the Health Department. We thank Russ Goeseke for stepping up on short notice to handle this Sunday's service, Pastor will be available by phone and you are welcome to call him as he will be working from home but won't be doing visits until after next Sunday. Please keep Pastor and his family in your prayers.
