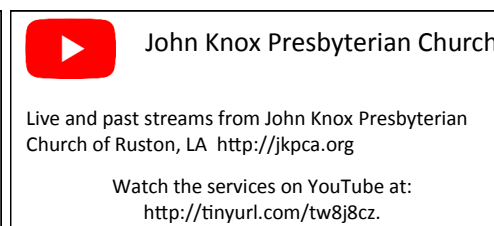
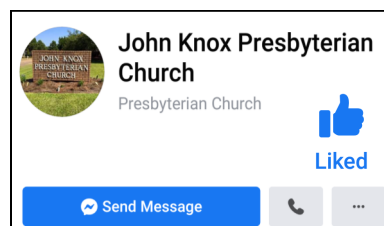
On The Radio Our Sunday Morning Service can be heard on KAPI FM 88.3 each Sunday from 10:30 a.m.—12 noon.

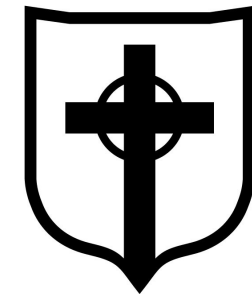
