## **Bulletin Announcements and Updates—**

"Adjust and Try Again"

I love football season, and I hope the college teams will be able to complete it, and you know what I mean! When I was playing high school football, I had two coaches with very different approaches, with distinct styles and attitudes. One had been at our school for years and was also a principal. He had a firm hand on the reigns of his program and was nearing the end of his coaching career. The other was new, but he had previously coached very successfully at another school. He felt the need to prove himself at this new school and was very intense and impatient and often angry with his players. The former coach was a patient teacher of the game. He enjoyed trying new approaches, but he never wavered in the basics of the foundational elements of blocking, tackling, hustle, strategy, and team spirit. The later coach was convinced the offense and defense he had used at his last school would work here and held to it exactly as he had done it before. The former coach, under whom I learned more than the other, had a philosophy to "adjust and try again." The other coach had a philosophy to "keep trying til you get it right." Now there is a place for both, sometimes we fail because we give up on an approach too soon when with practice it would have worked. But there is also a place for making adjustments in how we are doing things and trying it a little differently the next time. But in both approaches, there are fundamentals that must stay in place to be successful.

I feel we have had a similar experience at the Graham Street Church in 2020. The fundamental foundational elements of being a church of the Body of Christ stays the same. The core teaching of the Gospel, the importance of loving fellowship and service, the continued devotion to worship and prayer have not changed. But we have also experienced the clash of "keep trying it til you get it right" with "adjust and try again." There are some things that we have just had to do differently. We still worshipped, had Bible classes, served the needy, reached out to the lost, and provided shepherding to the weak and hurting. But in all of these we found trying to do it the way we have always done it was not going to reach our goals. So, we made adjustments and kept trying!

We would love to get back to one service where we can all come together in close contact to worship together Sunday mornings, but for now we need to keep making healthy adjustments to our meetings especially as flu season approaches while we are still dealing with the very serious Corona Virus. We have to continue to find the best ways to serve our community realizing that some of our old methods are not going to work right now, but the need is greater than ever. but we will have to continue to adjust our methods. We must continue to study God's Word and pray together, but we must adjust to using different tools God has provided to be successful. We must continue to give generously and spend wisely, but we have to adjust our goals and approaches to be effective stewards of our resources.

Of the two coaches, I enjoyed one more than the other and learned more about playing the game and living a better life. One coach frustrated me because he was frustrated that even with our efforts to try and try again harder we couldn't make it work, but we kept trying the same failing efforts and got the same results and more frustrated. The other coach taught me to love the strategy of adjusting and trying again, and I guess that's why I still love the third quarter (if you talk football strategy at half time you know what I mean!) I wish we had all of this strangeness behind us, but I think the third quarter may be ahead of us. Let's adjust and keep trying. We know we are going to win because the Lord is on our side!

40 Days for Life-Fall 2020 begins Wednesday, Sept. 23 through Sunday, Nov. 1. For 40 Days people around the world will join in prayer, fasting and peaceful vigil to end abortion where we live. This fall, 588 cities have registered groups covering 12-24 hours daily for 40 days, 63 nations have participated. Last year, Stephenville had its first 40DFL campaign, but does not have a registered site this fall. Some who prayed during the fall last year will still gather at the courthouse daily (40 days) to pray for the unborn, to pray for post-abortive mothers & fathers and the many workers where abortions happen. During election days, the site moves from the square to the courthouse annex across the street.
