Dear Friends,

Some of you may recall the best-selling 1967 novel *Christy* by author Catherine Marshall. Marshall's inspirational novels sold over 20 million copies and impacted countless lives. Yet before writing *Christy*, Catherine's first books were about her late husband, the Rev. Dr. Peter Marshall – a collection of his sermons and a biography. Dr. Marshall passed away in January 1949, at age 46. His wife Catherine was only 34 at the time.

I learned about Peter Marshall through my influential great-great aunt, Esther McCollough. Among the books I inherited after her death were Catherine's compilation of her husband's sermons, *Mr. Jones, Meet the Master* and her biography of him, *A Man Called Peter*. An immigrant from Scotland, Marshall quickly became the pastor of the influential New York Avenue Presbyterian Church in Washington, D.C., a highly respected church in its day and one which drew many of Washington's elite. Then, from January 4, 1947, and until his death, he served as the Chaplain for the United States Senate.



During these secular and politically caustic times of ours, it is almost impossible to imagine the period of 1947-1949 when, as Senate Chaplain, Marshall gained national notoriety, quoted in newspapers and capturing the nation's imagination with his uniquely picturesque Senate prayers. It is perhaps even harder to imagine that his ministry to the nation's senators actually had an affect upon their work and upon their lives. He was a unifying figure and a beacon for the truth of faith in the stormy Washington world.

Let us hope and believe that in our own fractured and broken generation, God will send a similar voice to minister to those in power and authority, and in so doing, to the nation as well. As Peter Marshall once prayed:

Bring us back to a faith that makes great and strong, a faith that enables us to love and to live, the faith by which we are triumphant, and the faith by which alone we can walk with Thee. We pray for a return to that simple faith, that old-fashioned trust in God, that made strong and great the homes of our ancestors who built this good land and who in building left us our heritage. Amen.

She said that over 504 gallons of milk had been delivered throughout the county by several different organizations thanks to Pace. New Business: Lucille Raines Home needs \$88,000 for a new air conditioning system. The West District UMW budget was reviewed.

Brooke Pike led the group in the World Thank Offering Program. The objective this year is "to understand how our gratitude to God can knit us together in community to share grace in the world". She read John 4:1-42, the story of the woman at the well. Samaritans and Jews did not mix with each other, but Jesus and the Samaritan woman talked and she shared the good news with other people in the village. Her gratitude to Jesus for recognizing her as a child of God is what the world thank offering emphasizes. Brooke listed some organizations that receive money to help children, youth, and families with different program. The group then discussed helping organizations in the local community. Brooke closed the program with prayer.

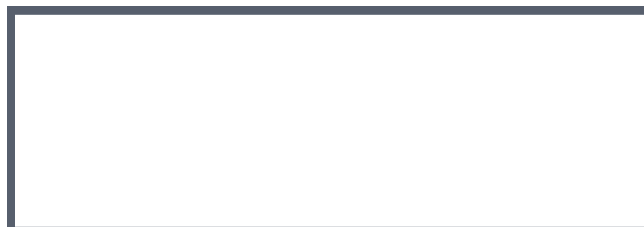

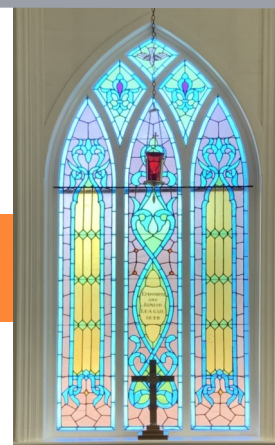
