Tell about a time you chose to do something Jesus wanted you to do even if you weren't sure how it would turn out. What was the situation, and what happened?




Make this page fly home!

Fold a flyer. When you get home...


...go for distance.

Here's how:


- 1 Fold the paper in half lengthwise as shown.




- 2 Unfold, and then fold the top two corners to the center line to create flaps.




- 3 Fold the top edges to the center of the paper.



- 4 Fold the plane in half.



- 5 Fold the wings down to meet the bottom edge of your plane's body.



- 6 Take aim, and let it fly!
