40 Days for Life-Fall 2020 begins Wednesday, Sept. 23 through Sunday, Nov. 1. For 40 Days people around the world will join in prayer, fasting and peaceful vigil to end abortion where we live. This fall, 588 cities have registered groups covering 12-24 hours daily for 40 days, 63 nations have participated. Last year, Stephenville had its first 40DFL campaign, but does not have a registered site this fall. Some who prayed during the fall last year will still gather at the courthouse daily (40 days) to pray for the unborn, to pray for post-abortive mothers & fathers and the many workers where abortions happen. During election days, the site moves from the square to the courthouse annex across the street.
