

“First Things First” Small Group Bible Study Outline for 2 Corinthians Study

Application Questions

How do we make application? By applying these 4 questions to our lives each week and sharing our experiences in our small group.

1. How were influenced through the Holy Spirit this week?
1. How were you committed to the identity and mission of Jesus this week?
2. In what ways did you react in faith and obedience this week?
3. How has God blessed your commitments this week?

Discussion of Personal Application to Last Week’s First Things Bible Study (1 Corinthians)

Examples:

- Taylor – “Perfectly united in mind” 1:10 “mind of Christ” 2:18 role of Spirit
- Wes – ‘Devil’s in the details’ division in Church
- David – not staying with Gospel (1), revelation of Spirit (2), foundation of Christ (3) causes division in Church

What were personal applications that came out of your small group discussion?

Bible Study for Next “First Things First” Scripture (2 Corinthians chapters 3-5) looking for the influence of the Holy Spirit, identity and mission of Jesus, and the response of belief and obedience of the Corinthians.

Some Notes on 2 Corinthians to Help your Discussion:

1. What does Paul say about the role of the Holy Spirit and our relationship with Jesus? (1:21-22; 3:6,17-18; 5:5)
2. How did our relationship with God change through Christ?
3. How do we reflect the glory of Christ and God?

Next Week’s Bible Study is from Galatians 2:20-4:7.
