Application Questions

How do we make application? By applying these 4 questions to our lives each week and sharing our experiences in our small group.

1. How were influenced through the Holy Spirit this week?
2. How were you committed to the identity and mission of Jesus this week?
3. In what ways did you react in faith and obedience this week?
4. How has God blessed your commitments this week?

3. To what roles are Paul and Timothy called and what are they to command and teach (1:12-20; 3:14-4:16; 6:3-10)?
