Voting Information

The 2020 General Election is **November 3, 2020**.

Visit Bernco.gov/clerk/elections to register, update your voter registration information, and/or request your absentee ballot. Online requests for absentee ballot applications are being accepted NOW. Do not wait until the last minute. Take no chances on mishaps or misdirection. This is too important.

Sample ballots are now available on the county websites. Please download a copy and read it thoroughly. There are many local issues to vote on.

If you are voting absentee, **please follow the instructions to the letter** otherwise, your ballot may be disqualified. We must be counted.

Key dates:

October 6, 2020 - Clerks begin mailing absentee ballots to voters who have requested them.

Absentee Voting Begins

Early Voting and Same Day Registration (SDR) at Clerk's Annex begins (Oct. 6-16, 2020, M-F 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.)

October 17-31, 2020 - 20 Early Voting

Convenience Centers will be open for the 2020 General Election. You may vote in person by machine or hand deliver your signed, sealed ballot.

Early Voting and SDR expand, Monday to Saturday, most locations open 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

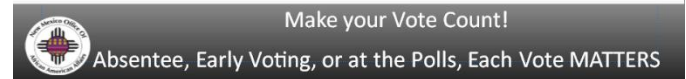
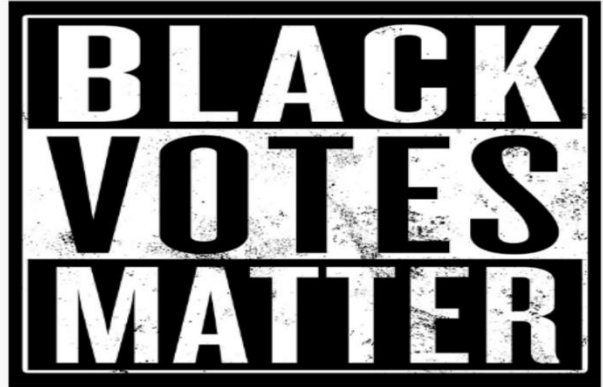
October 20, 2020 – Deadline for clerk to receive a mailed absentee ballot application

October 27, 2020 – Recommended final day for voter to mail absentee ballot to insure timely delivery.

November 3, 2020 – Election Day

Vote at any of the 72 Election Day Voting Convenience Centers open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
