





FOR PARENTS

In today's Bible story your child heard how Moses learned from his wife's father, Jethro (Exod. 18). The class discovered that God wants us to learn from our family members.

To help apply this lesson, focus on your child's choices this week. Whether the choice is what to wear, what to eat, where to go, or who to play with, help your child realize that he does make choices every day. Help him think about the possible results of each choice before he makes a final decision. Remind your child that God helps you as you help him make wise choices.

FOR TEACHER

Before class:

- Remove this page from the book.

During class:

- Talk about which pictures match, letting the students find and color one set of pictures before going on to another. Have them color as many sets of pictures as time permits.
- Have your students punch out the two pieces.
- Place the piece with the two wedges on top and insert a paper fastener through the Xs on both pieces.
- Show how to turn the wheel to see two matching pictures at the same time.

Optional:

- Glue the assembled picture wheel to the center of a small paper plate to give more sturdiness.

Talk about:

- The time when Jethro, Moses' father-in-law, helped him make wise choices.
- How we listen to others every day, and how parents and other adults can help us make good choices.
- The fact that God wants us to learn from our families.
