## **Bulletin Announcements and Updates—**

### **Restarting Classes on Sunday Mornings**

Our plan is to restart Bible Classes on Sunday Mornings in January 2021. This, of course, carries the caveat, depending on our ability to do so safely in the climate of COVID and other health matters at the time. Based on current trends, we will need to continue social distancing, and therefore we will still be offering two worship services, but the start times will be adjusted to allow for an hour of Bible Classes between the two worship services. The proposed schedule is:

8:30 for First Service; 9:45 for Bible Classes; 11:00 for Second Service

It is our hope that by restarting our Sunday morning classes, we can free more time for restarting our small group ministry on Sundays during the afternoon and evening as best fits each small group's schedule. It is suggested that small groups meet a minimum of once a month, and the leadership encourages small groups to meet twice a month on the first and third Sundays of each month. Sermon follow-up material will be furnished to small group leaders as a suggested Bible Study curriculum, and there is also small group resource material that has been developed and available on our website. The current Family Bible Class will continue to be offered at the building on the second and fourth Sunday nights of the month along with other fellowship, worship, and Bible Study options. We would also like to resume the 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday Singings. A time for the Sunday evening offerings will be determined later.

When we restart our Sunday Morning Bible Classes, we will offer classes for all ages Cradle Roll through Adults. The Adult classes will include a Bible text study (1 & 2 Peter taught by Mike Dacus) and a topical family support Bible study (GPS, Godly Parenting Skills, with David Bearden)

The Student Ministry Bible Classes will be divided into the following age and grade levels to start and be adjusted as needed: Cradle Roll (to 18 months), Toddlers (18 months to 3 years), 3s and 4s,  $K-2^{nd}$  grade,  $3^{rd}-5^{th}$  grade,  $6^{th}-8^{th}$  grade,  $9^{th}-12^{th}$  grade. I have talked to several teachers who are eager to teach again. If you are willing and able to teach, give me a call or email about what group you would like to teach, assist or substitute teach. We are trying to develop a large pool of teachers, assistants, and substitutes, so please volunteer. Our plan is to develop our curriculum based on "Stories of Faith." We feel this is a great time to review the great stories of God's faithfulness to His people who acted in great faith. Amen!

Taylor will also be offering a Bible class for those who are around the college age, whether they are attending college or not. We will come up with a name for this group, but you know who you are!

We are not planning a Wednesday night at the building program, but we will build into the Sunday Night Family Bible Class a family checkup and reinforcement of the lesson to run through the two weeks between classes.

There are no plans at this point to resume the "Worship Warriors" children's worship program during the Sunday morning worship services until we move back to one worship service on Sunday morning.
