- 4. Money Intentionally Maintained!** Commitment to regular giving, trusting God to supply.


Faith Promise Weekend—Sunday, November 1

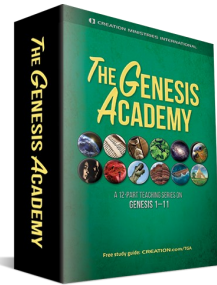

A new option this year is “**Pack a Box Online.**” For only \$25, you can choose items to be included in your box without the need to physically pack your box or to bring it to our church’s collection site. Samaritan’s Purse typically asks for \$9 to offset shipping costs of each box, but with the online option, the shipping cost is included, so the extra items only really cost \$16. Click on the link on our church’s website to start packing your box if you want to choose the online option. You can also still pack your own box, if you desire.



Angel Tree Ministry

Help make Christmas a more joyful event for families touched by the reality of prison as we partner once again with Prison Fellowship and provide gifts for local families who have a parent incarcerated. Sunday, November 1, 12:00PM to Monday, November 2, 12:00PM

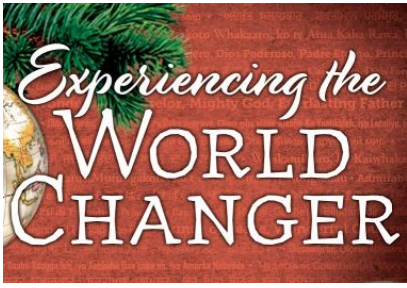
Join with us as we join other Christians from congregations across our movement for a day of united prayer. Set aside time during this emphasis to pray for our community, church and nation.
