



# Acts 23:12 - 24:27

## A plot to kill Paul (23:12-22)

1. Paul's \_\_\_\_\_ lived in the city and by God's \_\_\_\_\_ he discovered the Jews' plot (vv.16-22).
2. Paul instructs the \_\_\_\_\_ to take his nephew to the tribune (vv.16-17).
3. Paul's nephew told the \_\_\_\_\_ in private about the plot to kill his uncle (vv.18-22).

## The plot to kill Paul is exposed and frustrated (23:23-35)

1. Paul is sent to governor Felix \_\_\_\_\_ by 470 Roman soldiers (vv. 23-25).
2. As a Roman citizen, Paul had the whole \_\_\_\_\_ of the government behind him (vv. 26-34).
3. Paul was kept in Herod's \_\_\_\_\_ until the accusers arrived (vv. 35).

## Paul before Felix at Caesarea (24:1-21)

1. Tertullus began with \_\_\_\_\_ (vv. 1-4).

  - a. Paul is a \_\_\_\_\_ that stirs up riots among the Jews all over the world (v 5).

**Paul kept in custody (24:22-27)**
