"Looking Ahead"

It may seem strange to be spending time planning for next year in a time when everything seems to be changing, but we "strain forward to what lies ahead" (Phil. 3:13) with prayer and flexibility. We must apply careful strategies to do our part to not spread the virus to those who are at high risk, but we must stay on mission with prayer and planning.

Let me speak to some plans I am working on in my teaching and preaching ministry. As we look forward to the day when we can all be seated together in worship, I thought it would be a great time for us to study the topic of "worship." So, I am working on a sermon series to start in January called, "Come, Let's Worship Together," with Bible study discussion material for our small groups. These groups would meet on the first and third weeks and dig deeper into what we studied Sunday morning in the sermon. So, we need to start more groups and need more hosts and leaders. I am also excited about plans to work with Le Jones and his singing class in offering a "worship service" on the second and fourth Sunday nights (at the same time that we are offering the "Family Bible Class") where we can work on some new songs while we worship together.

I am also looking forward re-starting the GPS (Godly Parenting Skills) class. I am working on some curriculum to develop the "Rooted, Growing, and Reaching" mission of our Youth and Family Ministry at Graham Street Church. I am looking forward to studying the biblical principles of the joint effort of the church working in partnership with families to provide children with the spiritual foundation they need through a holistic support system for parents. I will partner with Wes to develop some exciting topics for discussion for our parents and teens, and even include some interaction from the children and teens. This will ultimately build a stronger Youth and Family Ministry, which will build stronger families, which will build a stronger church, which will be a support system to families beyond our church family.

I look forward to getting our Bible Classes going again on Sunday mornings, and we are still needing a few more teachers for our children, so let me know if you can help. I am also working on a Bible class for Wednesday nights that I will call, "Getting to Know Jesus." You will hear more about why I chose this topic Sunday morning in my sermon from Philippians, so be listening for it!
