- What is the difference between a God-given talent and a God-given gift in Romans 12?
- When have you clearly seen a spiritual gift in another person, and how did you know it was a spiritual gift?
- Tell us about a time your life was impacted by the way another person used his or her spiritual gift.
- This passage mentions several spiritual gifts—do any of them sound like a spiritual gift God has given you? Explain.
- Why do you think God decided to give us unique spiritual gifts and not just give us all the same gift or gifts?
- Choose one spiritual gift from this Scripture and talk about how it might look different in different situations.
- Look at verse 3—why do you think Paul included the warning against thinking “you are better than you really are” right before talking about spiritual gifts?

- If you know your spiritual gift(s), how are you using it currently to serve the body?
  - Do you need to change how you are serving to better exercise your gift? Where could you be better used?
- How could you use your spiritual gift at GRCC if you are not serving yet?
- If there is one way to use your spiritual gifts that would be a dream come true, what would it be? Why?
- *If you think you know what spiritual gifts God has given you, how have you learned to develop them?*
- *If you have no idea what spiritual gifts God has given you, what can you do to discover them?*
