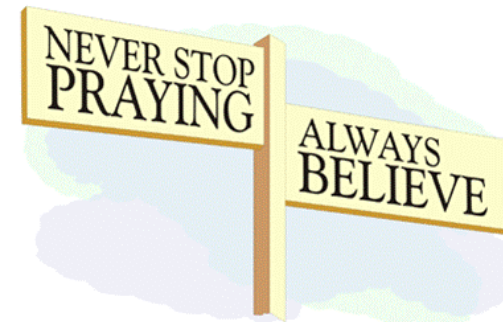

If you don't feel able to come up the stairs, you can let the ushers know and the pastors will bring communion to you, or you can come and sit in the front row on the pulpit side during distribution and the pastors will commune that as the last group.
