We are also going to briefly talk about the relationship between Naomi and Ruth. Ruth was a great example of how we can love our mom.


Bible Passage: Ruth 1:6-17

Folding Directions for Mother's Day Folding Puzzles

- 1. Copy the printable puzzle, using the double sided option on your printer. Cut out the square.
- 2. Fold square in half vertically, then fold in half horizontally. Open up paper.





3. Turn paper so "Happy Mother's Day!" side is up. Bring bottom corner up until the corner touches the center of the page and the edges match the fold lines in the paper. Continue folding each corner to the center. Line up the images as you fold.





4. Repeat step 3, bringing the corners of the puzzle up to touch the center of the puzzle, matching the image as you fold. You will see the following image:




5. Repeat step 4, bringing the corners of the puzzle up to tourch the center of the puzzle, matching the image as you fold.
