

Christ, the Lion and the Lamb (Revelation 5:1-14)

1) Understand the problem of sin... v. 1-4

& show compassion because of it.

“a scroll” -

“who is worthy to open the scroll” -

“no one in heaven or on earth or under the earth was able to open the scroll” -

“I began to weep” -

2) Know that our only hope is Christ... v. 5-7

& show Him the proper respect.

“one of the elders said, ‘weep no more’” -

“the lion... the root of David” -

“a lamb standing as though it had been slain” -

“seven horns” -

“seven eyes” -

“seven spirits of God” -

“he went and took the scroll” -

3) Our only response is worship... v. 8-14

& so how do you worship Christ?

Song 1: “the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders” v. 8-10

Song 2: “the voice of many angels numbering myriads and of myriads” v. 11-14

Discussion Questions:

- 1) Do we understand and grieve for the sin of the world?
- 2) Is this anguish enough to motivate you to action?
- 3) Will the things we do ever be enough to turn the tide of sin?
- 4) Why would we fear Christ as we would fear a Lion? How do we afford to him the respect that He deserves?
- 5) How is Christ both delicate and pure like a ‘little lamb’? How is He the ultimate definition of meekness?
- 6) Who are the four living creatures in the throne room of God? Who are the twenty-four elders? How does the mystery of these creatures & people add to the overall effect of this scene?
- 7) Why is the song of the angels saved till now?
- 8) How do you worship God these days?
