Dear Friends,

"O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" is one of the most well known and beloved hymns in the English-speaking world. It has been in common use for over a century and a half, but its origins are far more ancient.

A Latin chant titled, "Veni, veni, Emmanuel" was most likely composed in about the 12th century by some long-forgotten monk or nun in Europe. Just as we have Christmas carols and other such hymns that are used almost exclusively for Advent and Christmas, the Medieval church chanted a particular set of poems and scripture passages leading up to Christmas as well, all in Latin.

A large number of these chants were compiled into a special and influential collection in 1710, in Cologne, Germany. "Veni, veni, Emmanuel" was within that collection, and went on to be included in another big German collection of ancient music in 1844, the *Thesaurus Hymnologicus*.

An Anglican priest named John Mason Neale (1818-1866) utilized a copy of the *Thesaurus Hymnologicus* in an attempt to translate and revive some of the ancient church's hymns. He published his translation of "Veni, veni, Emmanuel" in 1861 and it soon rose to prominence. It was paired up with a similarly ancient, revised tune, the very same tune we recognize today.



"O Come, O Come, Emmanuel" is a true Advent hymn, as it looks ahead toward the coming of Christ. It is based in expectation and scriptural promise:

O come, O come, Emmanuel,
And ransom captive Israel,
That mourns in lonely exile here,
Until the Son of God appear.
Rejoice! Rejoice! Emmanuel
Shall come to thee, O Israel.

And, just to be clear, this wasn't the only great hymn Rev. Neale saved from ancient history and translated for future use. We also have him thank for "Good King Wenceslas," "All Glory, Laud and Honor," and several other great hymns of the church.

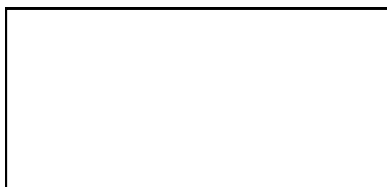

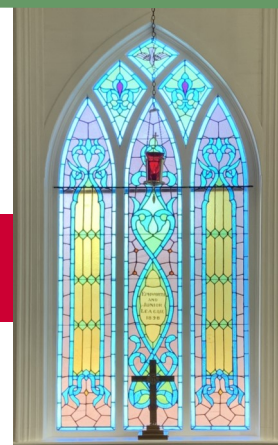
