# **AS WE GATHER**

We hear John the Baptist coming to prepare the way for the Lord, whose earthly birth we are preparing to celebrate and whose coming again on the Last Day is the promise of resurrection and eternal life for all who believe. Between our coming to faith and His coming again, we are called to lives of faith that continue to rejoice, to pray, and to give thanks in every circumstance. We rejoice with the psalmist, saying, "This is the day that the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it" (Psalm 118:24).



# **CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION**


- Behold, the true light has come into the world. Let us enter into His presence, confessing our sins P and receiving His forgiveness.
