

As We Gather

Isaiah 13–23 consists of ten sections labeled "Burdens." Isaiah 19 is the fifth "Burden" in the series. It deals with the future of Egypt. The first half of the chapter proclaims God's coming judgment against Egypt. God was using ancient Assyria to conquer land after land in order to change the international status quo. No longer would the Gentile nations continue to be autonomous, self-determining and self-oriented. God was in the process of turning them away from themselves and their own wisdom and religions. For what ultimate purpose? To turn them to the God of ancient Israel, the only true God.




