BLUEPRINT FOR A HEALTHY CHURCH

The Book of Titus

The churches on the island of Crete needed spiritual leadership, correction, and order. Establishing churches is Paul's calling and mission, but Paul doesn't sail to Crete to organize things. He already has someone on the island he can trust. That man is Titus. This short epistle unpacks Paul's list of things Titus should do: 1) Appoint leaders. 2) Instruct people to be sensible. 3) Encourage good deeds. The book of Titus is a guide to setting up order in the local churches of first-century Crete, but today it still gives us a theology of counter-cultural Christian living and enjoying a healthy and vibrant church experience.
