UPCOMING ADVENT SERVICES AT PEACE AND ENGLISH: December 16. Services at English at 12:00 noon and at Peace 7:00 p.m.

A DAY IN WORSHIP: Following the Proper Preface (the opening prayer of the communion liturgy) and the Sanctus, the pastor speaks the Words of Institution. The Words of Institution are the center of the service for two reasons. First, they remind us why we are doing what we are doing. We are taking communion because we are following Christ's command. He said, "Do this in remembrance of me." Secondly, in these words, we hear Christ tell us the Gospel very simply and personally. He said, "This is my body, which is given for you. This cup is the new testament in my blood, which is shed for you for the forgiveness of sins." Through this sacrament, Christ assures us that the benefits of his sacrifice on the cross are given to us. We receive his body and blood, broken and shed on the cross, for the forgiveness of our sins.

HYMN OF THE DAY: Our hymn of the day, *Hark the Glad Sound!*, captures the message of our Old Testament lesson. The savior comes, the savior promised long. He comes to release prisoners from Satan's bondage, to heal the broken hearted, to enrich the humble with the gift of God's favor. Therefore, let every heart prepare a throne and every voice a song.

ABOUT THE BULLETIN COVER: Ecce Agnus Dei! ("Behold the Lamb of God!") These Latin words appear on the ribbon held by John the Baptist in the seventeenth-century painting by Bernardo Strozzi. How fitting that when we sing the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) prior to Holy Communion, we are reminded of John's words and our reason for gathering. Christ's body and blood—along with the benefits of His sacrifice for us—are delivered, taking our sins away.

BAPTISMAL HYMN: I WANT TO WALK AS A CHILD OF THE LIGHT

- P Dearly beloved, Christ our Lord says in the last chapter of Matthew, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit." In the last chapter of Mark our Lord promises, "Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved." And the apostle Peter has written, "Baptism now saves you."

The Word of God also teaches that we are all conceived and born sinful and are under the power of the devil until Christ claims us as His own. We would be lost forever unless delivered from sin, death, and everlasting condemnation. But the Father of all mercy and grace has sent His Son Jesus Christ, who atoned for the sin of the whole world, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.

- P Oliver Hilbert, receive the sign of the holy cross upon your

 → heart to mark you as one redeemed by Christ the crucified.

Almighty and eternal God, according to Your strict judgment You condemned the unbelieving world through the flood, yet according to Your great mercy You preserved believing Noah and his family, eight souls in all. You drowned hard-hearted Pharaoh and all his host in the Red Sea, yet led Your people Israel through the water on dry ground, foreshadowing this washing of Your Holy Baptism. Through the Baptism in the Jordan of Your beloved Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, You sanctified and instituted all waters to be a blessed flood and a lavish washing away of sin.

We pray that You would behold Oliver according to Your boundless mercy and bless him with true faith by the Holy Spirit, that through this saving flood all sin in him, which has been inherited from Adam and which he has committed since, would be drowned and die. Grant that he be kept safe and secure in the holy ark of the Christian Church, being separated from the multitude of unbelievers and serving Your name at all times with a fervent spirit and a joyful hope, so that, with all believers in Your promise, he would be declared worthy of eternal life; through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

They are at all times to be examples to them of the holy life of faith in Christ and love for the neighbor.
