• INTRO

Welcome to Prayer Service! Tonight, we'll have a simpler format as we pray through Psalm 17 and sing some songs of the Season. We're just going to spend some time reflecting on Psalm 17, praying for God to draw our attention to the specific ways and passages He wants to speak to us. We come tonight expectant, believing that God speaks to His people, His sheep know His voice, and the Spirit will use these Godbreathed words to speak in a special way to us again tonight. At the end, we want to pray for specific prayer concerns, so if you're watching the livestream, comment if you have particular prayer requests. If you're watching later on, use that time to lift up your particular requests on your own. Let's pray.

• PAUSE

"As I enter prayer now, I pause to be still; to breathe slowly; to re-center my scattered senses upon the presence of God." (Lectio365) *Pause and pray.*

As we read **Psalm 17** together, be open with the parts that confuse or challenge you; meditate on the parts that stand out to you:

"1 Hear me, Lord, my plea is just; listen to my cry. Hear my prayer—it does not rise from deceitful lips. 2 Let my vindication come from you; may your eyes see what is right. ³ Though you probe my heart, though you examine me at night and test me, you will find that I have planned no evil; my mouth has not transgressed. 4 Though people tried to bribe me, I have kept myself from the ways of the violent through what your lips have commanded. 5 My steps have held to your paths; my feet have not stumbled. ⁶ I call on you, my God, for you will answer me; turn your ear to me and hear my prayer. ⁷Show me the wonders of your great love, you who save by your right hand those who take refuge in you from their foes. 8 Keep me as the apple of your eye; hide me in the shadow of your wings 9 from the wicked who are out to destroy me, from my mortal enemies who surround me. 10 They close up their callous hearts, and their mouths speak with arrogance. 11 They have tracked me down, they now surround me, with eyes alert, to throw me to the ground. 12 They are like a lion hungry for prey, like a fierce lion crouching in cover. 13 Rise up, Lord, confront them, bring them down; with your sword rescue me from the wicked. 14 By your hand save me from such people, Lord, from those of this world whose reward is in this life. May what you have stored up for the wicked fill their bellies; may their children gorge themselves on it, and may there be leftovers for their little ones. 15 As for me, I will be vindicated and will see your face; when I awake, I will be satisfied with seeing your likeness."

PSALM 17

Let's just take some time to soak in this Word for a while. Reread Psalm 17 on your own—slowly, prayerfully. Ask God to draw your attention to a specific word or phrase that He wants you to focus on.

"Hear me, Lord, my plea is just; listen to my cry.
