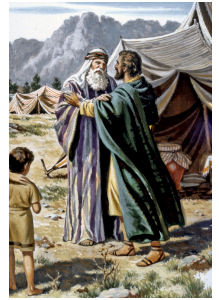


Yitro: Jethro

His Abundance

(#17) **Exod. 18:1-20:26; Isaiah 6:1-7:6; 9:5-6; Matthew 5:21-30; 15:1-11; 19:16-30; Mark 7:5-15; 10:17-31; Luke 18:18-30; Acts 6:1-7 Romans 2:17-29; 7:7-12; 13:8-10; Ephesians 6:1-3; 1 Timothy 3:1-14; 2 Timothy 2:2; Titus 1:5-9; Hebrews 12:18-29; James 2:8-13; 1 Peter 2:9-10** Yitro is a man of the world, (sounds like us). Why does Yitro come to Moses? Because the whole world heard about the Red Sea disaster, and then another nation destroyed, the Amalekites!! Yitro was a seeker of Truth, a heart for God's truth! He then gives his life to Yahweh, making an offering to HIM, and becomes one of the First Fruits of the Gentiles. Yahweh gives us guidance; The Ten Words-Aseret haDevarim. (John 1) Yeshua at Mount Sinai-Horeb.



Are the 10 Commandments PC, Politically Correct??

Haftarah: A quick summary of these scriptures: 7 Points: Isaiah 6:1-7:6, & 9:5-6; The Vision of the Glory of Yahweh; (#1) v: 6-7, the famous calling "Coal, touched to his lips"; (#2) v.8, Isaiah breaks the coal, and Yahweh, this is His "salvation and calling;" "Go and tell this people", who is He supposed to go to?? (#3) v: 13, A remnant shall be saved. (#4) This famous quote Isa. 6:9 And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. (#5) Isa 6:10 Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and turn again, and be healed. This is a very important scripture even Messiah Quoted it; Mat 13:14; John 12:40; Act 28:27. (#6) Isaiah 7:1-6, Ephraim and Israel joined forces against Judah; (#7) Yahweh explains the Messiah's coming, (Isa 9:6-7), by HIS birth & kingdom of Messiah; note the son is called the "Father and God", how does this work into your brain??



A Few Hebrew Definitions



- a) Peculiar; חֶסֶד H5459 **segûllâh**: special treasure, hidden in Him, treasure. **Ex 19:5**
- b) Bowed Down; H7812 שָׁחָה **shâchâh**: to bow down, prostrate oneself, this is also "Worship".
- c) Depart, send: H7971 שָׁלַח **shalach**: to send, send away, let go, stretch out, **to sow. Ex 18:27**
- d) Sanctify/Consecrate; H6942 קָדַשׁ **Kadosh**: to consecrate-sanctify, set-apart, dedicate, hallowed, holy, be separate **Ex 19:10.**
- e) Bribe/Gift H7810; שָׁחַד **Shachad**: present, bribe, gifts of seduction from the world. **Ex 23:8; Dt 16:19, I Sam 12:3. (hating Covetousness 18:21)**
- f) 'Suffer' Greek- G5278 ὑπομένω **hupomeno**: Thayer's: to remain, to tarry behind, abide, not recede or flee, to hold fast to one's faith in Messiah, to endure, bear bravely, & calmly: ill treatments, the least.

Notes that point to Yeshua

- 1- **Exo 18:9-11 Jethro / Yitro, (Ex 3:1, 4:18) the first real picture** of a type and shadow of an outsider/Gentile/the Early gathering/Kahol being the first fruits of the blessings of Yahweh. **Acts 10:45** "and they of the circumcision that believed were amazed, as many as came with Peter, because that on the Gentiles also was poured out the gift of the Holy Spirit."
- 2- **V.12, Yitro confesses his life in the world**, his idols and life as a priest of his worldly ways. He submits to Yahweh and offers a sacrifice. Are we his priests HIS Way or still our Worldly ways?
- 3- **Yitro repents, makes an offering, and is circumcised.** See **Number 15:16 & Exo 12:48.** (1) Do we repent? (2) Have we made an offering of ourselves? (3) Do we have the circumcised heart? **Gal 4:1-3,** Child heir-Slave, **Matt 18:1-3,** you must be like a child, to learn faith.
- 4- **Yitro is a sojourner, an alien;** a Gentile/Goy comes into the nation of Israel. He had to be converted with circumcision of flesh and heart. **Heb 11:9-16-Stranger & Aliens.**
 - a. **Rom 2:28-29** "For he is not a Jew, which is one outwardly; neither [is that] circumcision, which is outward in the flesh; But he [is] a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision [is that] of the heart, in the spirit, [and] not in the letter; whose praise [is] not of men, but of God."
- 5- **Exo 18:27 "depart" H7971 shalach: to sow, spread. This is the word used to send Yitro back to his home, to sow the Word.** He goes back into Midian and converts his family. The ancient sages say he came back and lived with Israel.
 - a. **Do we even know what His commandments are?? John 15:10** "If you guard-shamar My commands, you shall stay in My love, even as I have guarded My Father's commands and stay in His love.
 - b. **Mat 28:20** "Teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, [even] unto the end of the world." Amen.
 - c. **Mat 28:19** "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, Mikveh, (repent) them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost."

Keep the Fire!

- 2- In Ex 18:8-11; do you think Yitro believed all the miraculous things that Moshe told him concerning Yahweh? Yes, verse 12 confirms his desire to be a Child of the Living God of Moses and Abraham.
- 3- What do you think this next verse, 12 confirms? This is his conversion to the Walk, I also believed he and His family were circumcised, flesh and heart.
- 4- For the Math people, in 18:21 what percentage of the people would this ratio be? This is important. 13.1%
- 5- If there were 3 million people then how many people would be leaders? If there were 5 million people how many would there be? How do you think this relates to Matt 5:19, the greatest? 393,000 and 655,000, I think this is a picture of the work of Yeshua, to be the leaders and sub leaders in the Kingdom, as Yeshua described in Matt 5:19 about the greatest.
- 6- In Ex 18:27, Moses 'sent' his father-in-law on his way; the word 'sent' has a special meaning in Hebrew, 'to sow'. Look up in your Strong's or Brown's and tell me this word in Hebrew? This understanding of the word is powerful that the sages even believe that Yitro went home and converted his people to Yahweh. Shalach, to send or to sow.
- 7- In 19:5 what does 'Peculiar people' (KJV) mean to you? Look it up in Hebrew and it will give you a special meaning of who you are!! Look these up and you will have a special understanding of how precious you are Exo 19:5; Deu 7:6; Deu 14:2; Deu 26:18; 1Ch 29:3; Psa 135:4; Ecc 2:8; Mal 3:17; Segullah: special treasure, possession, jewel, peculiar
- 8- In 19:6 we see a special description that is quoted by Peter; can you find this? 1Pet. 2:9
- 9- In Ex 19:6 whom is Moses talking about? In Peter, whom is he talking about? They are both talking about the Firstborn of Yeshua to be a Kingdom of priests. Those called unto His light (ora) Torah! Notice the Ten Words, (commandments) haven't been given yet, (Chapter 20), so what do you think they mean in 19:7-8? They would obey whatever He said; they agreed to obey because He was God. They didn't even know all of the commandments yet. However, they did know God's teaching and instruction, because they had it passed down from their ancestors.
- 10- In 19:10-11, what do you think it means to;
- Sanctify/Consecrate them? Kadosh
 - To wash your clothes? To set apart repent be purified and clothed in His righteousness.
 - And what does the 3rd day mean to you? 3rd day was the time for cleansing and purification Numbers 19:1-12
- 11- In English the word was translated as trumpet, Ex 19:16; but what is this word in Hebrew? H7782 Shofar
- 12- We see in Ex 19:23 there are limits in our approach to Yahweh? When God set up the tabernacle there was something that kept the people out of the Holy of Holies, where Yahweh lives, what is it? The veil kept everyone except the high priest from coming into Yahweh presence.
- 13- In Eph 2:14 what happened to it, from the previous question? The veil was torn so that we can now enter the holy of holies.
- 14- When Yeshua told us the greatest commandments, (Matt 22:37-40) can you find these in the ten from Exo 20? If not, what do you think Yeshua meant? No neither of them is a commandment by itself. These two summarize all of the commandments and all of God's teaching and instruction. They are the fulfillment of the Torah. Love of God and man,
- 15- What do you think Yeshua meant in 22:40 of Mattityahu (Matthew)? All of God's teachers based their teaching on the understanding of these two principles. These commandments are based upon the foundation of Torah and the Prophets.

Isaiah 6:1-7:6; 9:5-6;



- I. We see that Uzziah the King just died; was he a righteous King? (II Chron 26)
 - a. So who was the next king and was he righteous? (II Chron 27)
 - b. Were the people righteous and following Yahweh's teachings and instructions at this time? (II Chron 27:2)
- II. If God's people were not righteous then how could the Seraphim say, "the whole earth is filled with God's Glory"? 6:3
- III. What was Isaiah really saying in 6:5?
- IV. In 6:6-7, this picture being referred is a picture of our lives can you explain?
- V. What does this passage in 6:9-10 really mean and why?
 - a. Did anyone ever quote this and why?
- VI. Can you find in the Torah and the Brit any scriptures that Yahweh will harden or make hearts calloused? And what do you think Yahweh's purpose was??
- VII. In 6:11-13, we can see the actual prophesy about the nation Israel and Judah, but will you explain how this is for today?
