*Exod. 13:17-17:16; Judges 4:4-5:31; (#16)*

**Luke 2:22-24; John 6:25-35; 19:31-37; 1 Corinthians 10:1-13; 2 Cor 8:1-15; Revelation 15:1-4**

Yahweh becomes the Guide to the Children, Joseph is honored; It's all about His presence; Cloud & Fire. Just this section alone has three different examples of our lives; "Murmuring, grumbling, complaining", all Evil Tongue, La shon Hara. I think we are just like them. Oh, plus there are many signs & wonders. Is that for the believers or the unbelievers? We also have water from the Rock, Yeshua (1Cor 10:4) & the Tree of Life; "Etz Chaim".

**Haftarah: Judges 4.4-5.31; Just as the God fearing Moses went to Battle and God prevailed, Devorah was God's anointed and God miraculously confused and prevailed over the Canaanites and Yahweh prevailed. [A Good Summary see Isaiah 43:15-20](#)**



## A Few Hebrew Definitions



- 1- Depart, send: H7971 שָׁלַח **shalach**: to send, send away, let go, stretch out, **to sow**. Ex 18:27
- 2- Deliverance/Salvation: H3444 יְשׁוּעָה **Yeshua**: salvation, deliverance, used 78 times
- 3- Tree/wood: H6086 עֵץ **etz**: tree, timber, plank, stalk, stick, **gallows, wood for death**.
- 4- Waters: H4325 מַיִם **Mayim**: waters; Is your water alive & living? **Mayim Chaim**.
- 5- Ordinance: H4941 מִשְׁפָּט **Mishpat**: judgment, justice, ordinance, Exo 15:25
- 6- Voice: H6963 קוֹל **Kol**: voice, sound, noise
- 7- The Lord Healeth: Yahweh (YHVH-H3068) יְהוָה רַפָּה **Raphah** (H7495) **Yahweh Raphah** Exo. 15:26
- 8- Yahweh is my Banner; H3071, יְהוָה נִסִּי **YHVH-Nissi** **Yahweh-Nissi**. Exo 17:15 ; S of S. 2:4



## Notes that point to Yeshua & >>>>> You!!

- 1- **Yahweh/Yeshua becomes their Guide, Our Guide**, but in Exo 33 we see the debate between Moses and Yahweh; that God was not going to be their guide through the wilderness, but an Angel. (Exo 33:3) I will not go with you, but in v. 15-17, Yahweh concedes to go because "I KNOW YOUR NAME!"
  - a. Heb 13:5 "...for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee." Deut 31:8.
  - b. Exo 6:8 "Yahweh brings them to the land, and unto thy holy habitation." Exo 15:13
- 2- **He knows your name!!**
  - a. Rev 2:17 "...To he that overcomes, to him will I give of the hidden manna, and I will give him a white stone, and upon the stone a new name written, which no one knows but he that receives it." Jer 32:39 "and I have given to them one heart."
- 3- In 13:17-18, Yahweh purposely leads them away from War. They weren't ready for the trials, they are new-borns; they just received the Blood of the Lamb on their houses, like we, as the born again babes, but the time is coming on us fast that we should mature and go to War!! Acts 7:39; Heb 5:12-14; II Cor 10:3-5, Heb 5:12-6-2
- 4- **Pharaoh had them trapped against the Sea of Reeds** or maybe the Gulf of Aqaba so what did they do? Exo 14:10 "The Children of Israel cried unto the Lord"; v.11 "they" complained to Moses, "they", probably didn't know The God of their fathers. It is estimated many thousands/millions of Egyptians came with the children. That is why from the very beginning the "strangers, sojourners, & aliens among you" must transform by circumcision & keeping Torah, was mentioned so many times; we have the circumcision of the Heart. Deut. 10:16; 30:6
- 5- **Look at v.13, Exo 14. Then Moses said**, "See (ra'ah, or experience), Salvation, Yeshua, the Salvation of Yahweh" This word salvation is Yeshua, (H3444) יְשׁוּעָה *yesh-oo'-aw* Yeshua, is used 78 times in the Tanakh; salvation or deliverance. They saw/experienced the "Living Word" of Yahweh, Yeshua, open the sea to dry land, they knew his mighty right arm. 1Co 10:2 "All were baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea;"
  - a. Isa 12:3 "Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation."
  - b. **These are your enemies that need to die**, and you should never see them anymore!! Gal 5:19-21
- 6- **SOD (Hidden Meaning)--Read this in the KINGDOM! The LORD shall fight for you, and ye shall hold your peace.** Exo 14:14 Be quiet, be still, give up from your own deeds; let him build your faith, your life - your covenant upon your heart. This hard lesson only comes from the Holy Spirit. If we do God's work, or His vengeance then we are not in HIM.

**Stand still &  
see the Salvation  
of Yahweh - Yeshua!**

- a. **Isa 30:15** “For the Lord, the Holy One of Israel, said, (1) In quiet and rest is your salvation: (2) peace and hope are your strength: but you would not have it so.”
- b. **Rom 8:35-37** “Who shall separate us from the love of Yeshua? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? As it is written, for your sake we are killed all the day long; we are accounted as sheep for the slaughter. No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.”
- c. **1Pe 1:6-7** “Wherein ye greatly rejoice, though now for a season, if need be, ye are in heaviness through various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perishes, though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:”
- d. **I Kings 19:11-12**, “There was a wind, an earthquake, and a fire but Yahweh was not in them, but then Elijah heard a “still, small, voice”. He is fighting for us, If, If, If we are still from our labors, our flesh fight.
- 7- **Exo 14:19-20. This is so awesome and it is for you today.** In times of real trouble, Yahweh and the Cloud of witnesses will cause you to be in light and the rest of the world will be in complete darkness, and you will be in HIS Rest and Shalom. ARE YOU THERE RIGHT NOW?
- 8- **‘Throw this tree or wood into the bitter water to make it Sweet’.** This is the Redeemed Yeshua after His authority was given after the death. **Exo 15:25** There has been an intensive search over the ages for this tree, a tree or piece of wood that will make the bitter waters sweet! Even the Bedouins have searched for this type of wood. This wood is from HIS Words of Yahweh. The Hebrew word used here for tree is רֶשֶׁת ‘ates’. It also known as timber, tree, wood, or gallows. Gallows represent death. The death of Yeshua on a tree gave life to all that are HIS. This water was death until the tree brought it to life. Can you see the parallels in Torah to Yeshua? Take your bitter life and put it into YESHUA.
- 9- **Exo 15:26 The Lord that healeth, Yahweh Rapha,** (H7495) (Jehovah Raphah-Healeth)
- 10- **Exo 15:27 There were 12 wells of Mayim, Living water, Yeshua, and 70 Trees.** This is a picture of life, Yeshua, (Living Waters). Living waters is now available to each of the twelve tribes and the 70 trees are also a picture of their beginnings in Egypt, (**Exo 1:5**), There were seventy people from the loins of Jacob that entered into Egypt; also these 70 trees are at their beginning of deliverance, they also may represent the 70 Elders, or the 70 nations of Noah, or the seventy nations represented in the upper room. Yahweh makes provision for all Israel; you can’t miss Him if you tried.
- a. **In Numbers 11:25 the Holy Spirit rested** on the 70 Elders and they prophesied. Seventy years of captivity in Babylon prophesied by Isaiah and Jeremiah.
- b. **Yeshua sent out the seventy, Luke 1:1-24** A picture of the 70 nations, the goyim.
- c. **Rev 22:2-3** “...in the midst of the street thereof. And on this side of the river and on that was the tree of life, bearing twelve manner of fruits, yielding its fruit every month: and the leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations. And there shall be no curse any more: and the throne of God and of the Lamb shall be therein: and his servants shall serve him;”
- 11- **In 16:2; They grumbled-murmured about the bread of life,** Yahweh gave them **‘Bread from Heaven-Yeshua’ v.4.** They received quail at night & Manna by day. **V. 13.** Yeshua taught us about New Wine in New Wineskins, This is the new manna everyday.
- 12- **If they didn’t get the ‘Bread of Life-from Heaven-Yeshua,** fresh each day, then yesterdays was filled with maggots-worms and smells really, really bad. Bad smelling and full of worms, this is our “Traditions of Man-Religion v.24, it did not smell bad or get worms until Sabbath!!! What would happen if you kept it until Sunday? (\*\*The same word used for worm is used for scarlet and crimson) Our Sin is like scarlet, and the worms are eating the worms.
- a. **\*\*Isa 1:18** “Come now, let us reason together... though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they be red like crimson, they shall be as wool.”
- b. **Joel 2:25** “And I will restore to you the years that the locust hath eaten, the cankerworm, and the caterpillar, and the palmerworm, my great army which I sent among you.”
- c. **Joel 1:4** “That which the palmerworm hath left hath the locust eaten; and that which the locust hath left hath the cankerworm eaten; and that which the cankerworm hath left hath the caterpillar eaten.”
- 13- **Exod 17:1-7, Remember this story of “no water”** at Rephidim, which we will illustrate in future studies. This was named Massah and Meribah- “Tempting and Murmuring (bitter)”.
- 14- **Exo 17:1-7, & Exo 15:22-27; This water is their Salvation-Yeshua,** Their own personal Rock (**I Cor 10:3-4**). The Rock of Salvation (**Deut 32:4, 15**), but it comes from within the Rock, after the 1<sup>st</sup> hit, (symbol of crucifixion). It was after they ‘Drank from the Rock” were they allowed to go to Battle, notice **13:17**, the Lord avoided battle until they had the ‘Rock’.
- 15- **Exod 17:8-16 The warfare is strong, and the Rod, Torah, God’s Word** must be lifted up. Are you the armor bearer that’s lifting up the work of the LORD?
- 16- **Exod 17:15 Yahweh-Nissi; Yahweh is my banner,** “His banner over me is Love.” **S. Solomon 2:4**
- 17- **Exod 17:16 Yahweh fights this “Amalek Spirit” in every generation. It’s in us, “Don’t lag behind” Be Fervent in Spirit Rom 12:11**
- 18- **The Lashon Hara Summary of this Study. 4 Times in this section alone they Lashon Hara.**
- a. **14:10 They complained** about the walk-Halachah.
- b. **15:22-25 ‘No Water’** Salvation-Yeshua turns the bitter water to sweet. ‘Mayim Chaim’. **John 4:13-15**
- c. **16:2 ‘No food for life’** Yahweh gives them Yeshua, ‘Bread of Life’. ‘Lechem Chaim’, **John 6:35**
- d. **17:2** At Rephidim, again for ‘No Water’, Now they have a **Rock** that will follow them, **I Cor 10:4.**
- 19- **How is your grumbling,** complaining, murmuring, Lashon hara going? Is it getting you anywhere in HIM, or have you become spiritually DEAD? This is a great picture of our lives, our walk, our food & water!! Does your manna smell, or are you into the word each day-Yeshua!!!

**Exod 14:14 “The LORD shall fight for you.” (if-if-if) you hold your peace.**

## The Answers & Questions- Exod. 13:17-17.16.

- 1- **When they left Egypt they took Joseph's Bones, Why?** Joseph had made them promise to carry his bones back with them when God delivered them out of Egypt. Gen 50:25
- 2- **Why didn't Yahweh take them directly to Canaan Land?** To keep them from WAR!!(13:17-18)
- 3- **When the Israelites realized that the entire Egyptian army and Chariots had trapped them at the Sea, what kindly and Faithful words did they use?** They continue in Lashon Hara. Exo 14:11-12
  - a. **When we have trials, hurts, pains, sorrows, disappointments, financial problems, and more, what type of kindly praise and faithful words do you use?** Just like them we are learning to praise Yahweh for His Guidance, Exo 14:14, We will be still or shut up and he will fight our battles, Praise Yahweh.
- 4- **Exo. 14:13 uses a Hebrew word for 'deliverance' or 'salvation', what do you think Moses meant when he said "see (Ra'ah) the salvation/deliverance of the LORD", (KJV)?** This word is used 78 times in the OT it is Yeshua. He is our Rock and our salvation, so experience Yeshua as he parts your troubles. Praise Him.
- 5- **One of the most powerful scriptures is Exo 14:14; what does this mean to you? Do you really believe it enough to do it? Get rid of self will.** This is a lesson that is hard to learn, my counsel is full of this scripture, try to stop taking it out of God's hands.
- 6- **In 14:24 we see YHVH is between the Egyptians and the Israelites in the Pillar of Fire, so who was holding back the Sea, (Yam)?** Yeshua, Salvation-Deliverance.
- 7- **In the Movie by Cecile B. Demille, how many Egyptians survived the receding waters? In the Exodus how many survived?** In the movie Pharaoh survived, but in the real Exodus, no one made it. 14:28
- 8- **This experience of going into the waters with the old man and coming out a new 'born again' life has a few pictures!! Can you name a few of them?** Mikveh, the Greek word, baptizo or baptize. Where can you find this in the Brit (NT)? I Cor 10:1-4
- 9- **In Exo 14:30-31 'They Saw'; what did they see? And what did it cause them to do? What have you seen that adds to your faith?** They saw the judgment of Egypt-Death. This is the Fear of the Lord, Number #1, and then they put their faith in Yahweh. Ps 111:10 and Prov 1:7
- 10- **What was so different this time when they 'saw', (Exo 14:30-31) from the 10 plagues? And why did they curse Moses in 14:10-12?** With the plagues, only the Egyptians were affected – the Israelites weren't touched by the plagues, and because they were still in bondage to the Egyptians, I don't think there was as much fear of being killed – they hadn't tasted freedom yet, and knew the Egyptians wanted them there as slaves...but after they had been delivered, they almost started to take their freedom for granted – so when they saw the Egyptians coming, and knowing that they were against the sea, all they saw before their eyes was their enemy and death...whereas in Egypt, though they had enemies, they also had a 'life. Even Fear can be so strong it will cause you to curse, Moses and even Yahweh!!
- 11- **Chapter 15 has the Song of Moses, where can you find the second song of Moses, the One that we sing now?** Deut 32, the 2nd Song of Moses, and now in Rev 15:1-4.
- 12- **Chapter 15:1-21 is a great picture of a revival meetings, great worship and dance, Salvation, rejoicing over God's Deliverance, Yeshua. Then they did something just like us the next day, what is it, (15:22-26). What is this Hebrew concept, (evil tongue)? (Did you know this is one of the worst sins in the Torah?)** Lashon Hara is the worst sin in the Torah, look at Miriam, Korath, Dathan, and Abiram, plus all Israel.
- 13- **In 15:25, what do you think the 'tree' or 'wood' represents?** This word 'etz or ates' also is the wood used for gallows. It is a picture of the tree that Yeshua was crucified on, and his Resurrection. He is the only ingredient for 'sweet life'.
- 14- **In 15:26 what is one of the names of Yahweh?** Yahweh Rapha - the God who heals you!
- 15- **In 15:27 what do you think the 12 springs and 70 palms trees represent?** There were 12 wells of Mayim, Living water, Yeshua, and 70 Trees. This is a picture of life, Yeshua, (Living Waters). Living waters is now available to each of the twelve tribes and the 70 trees are also a picture of their beginnings in Egypt, (Exo 1:5), There were seventy people from the loins of Jacob that entered into Egypt; also these 70 trees are at their beginning of deliverance, they also may represent the 70 Elders, or the 70 nations of Noah, or the seventy nations represented in the upper room. Yahweh makes provision for all Israel; you can't miss him if you tried.
- 16- **Chapter 16 is all about something we are learning not to do, just like we saw in 15:24. In 16:2 they did it again, what is this?** Murmuring, Grumbling-Lashon Hara. Can you find any NT Scriptures? I Cor 10:10; Phil 2:14; John 6:43; Gal 5:19-21; Eph 4:31; Col 3:8; I Pet 2:1; 2 Tim 3:1-5; Rom 16:17-18
- 17- **In Chapter 17 they continued to 'Lashon Hara' about the water; can you find a verse in the NT (Brit Hadashah) that tells us who the Rock (water) is?** I Cor 10:3-4; Rom 9:32-33; I Pet 2:8; \*Luke 6:48\*
- 18- **In 17:10 whom do Aaron and Hur represent? Can you see why the Body of the Living Messiah needs you? Don't go to service to 'be fed', go to feed the body. Bring your gift to the Bride!! Aaron and Hur are pictures of you, they are the Body lifting up Yeshua, the ministry and the Bride.**

**The ministry is called to 'feed His Sheep', (John 21:16-17), if we are a nation and Kingdom of priests, then you are called. Bless Him for all the Fire He is putting in your life and family.**

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# A Study on The Pure Heart (We need one!)

Use this as a Bible Study around the dinner table, it will get into your "Hearts".

## Do we really have it??

Psa 73:1 "A Psalm of Asaph. Truly God is good to Israel, to those who are of a pure heart."

Psa 73:13 "Surely in vain have I cleansed my heart, And washed my hands in innocence:"

Pro 20:9 "Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin?"

Jer 4:14 "O Jerusalem, wash your heart from wickedness, that tyou may be saved. How long shall your vain thoughts lodge within you?"

Act 15:8-9 "And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as [he did] unto us: & put no difference between us and them, purifying their hearts by faith."

Joel 2:13 "And rend your heart, and not your garments, and turn unto the LORD your God: for he [is] gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and repenteth him of the evil."

2Co 7:1 "Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God."

1Ti 1:5 "Now the end of the commandment is charity out of a pure heart, and [of] a good conscience, and [of] faith unfeigned:

2Ti 2:22 "Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart."

Heb 10:22 "Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water."

1Pe 1:22 "Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren, [see that ye] love one another with a pure heart fervently:"

Psa 34:18 "The LORD [is] nigh unto them that are of a broken heart: and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit."

Jam 4:8 "Draw nigh to Yahweh, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners: and purify your hearts, you (will) be double minded."

Eze 9:4 "And the LORD said unto him, Go through the midst of the city, through the midst of Jerusalem, and set a mark upon the foreheads of the men that sigh and that cry for all the abominations that be done in the midst thereof."

2Ki 22:19 "Because thine heart was tender, and thou hast humbled thyself before the LORD, when you heard what I spoke against this place, and against the inhabitants thereof, that they should become a desolation and a curse, and hast rent thy clothes, and wept before me: I also have heard you; says Yahweh."

Psa 51:17 "The sacrifices of God [are] a broken spirit: a broken despise."
