Title: The Holy Catholic Church III

Introduction

I. How may the true church be distinguished from the false? By the marks of the True Church (WCF 25.4) *The first mark of the true church is the pure preaching and teaching of the truth of God's Word.*

- II. The Second Mark by which the True Church of the Lord Jesus Christ may be identified is the pure Administration of the Sacraments.
 - A. How are the sacraments to be observed? The sacraments are to be observed in accordance with their nature, in accordance with the manner in which the Lord has instituted them, in accordance with our Lord's own word.
 - B. According to their Nature
 - C. Manner of Christ's institution and according to His Word
 - D. With a serious and holy regard for Christ and His benefits
