115 What should be your attitude toward sin?

I should hate and resist it, be deeply grieved by it, ask God's forgiveness for it, and earnestly try to put it away.

1 John 2:1-2 My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. He is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the sins of the whole world.

116 Can you perfectly keep God's Ten Commandments?

No, because I was born a sinner, I cannot perfectly keep God's law.

James 2:10 For whoever keeps the whole law but fails in one point has become guilty of all of it.

117 What judgment does God pronounce upon you because of your failure to obey His law perfectly?

My judgment is eternal death.

Galatians 3:10 For all who rely on works of the law are under a curse; for it is written, "Cursed be everyone who does not abide by all things written in the Book of the Law, and do them."

118 What help, then, is there for you?

I may be saved through the grace of Jesus Christ offered to me in the Gospel.

John 3:16-17 "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. 17 For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.

119 Who alone has fulfilled the Ten Commandments for you?

Jesus alone has fulfilled the law for me by His perfect obedience.


Romans 5:10 For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life.
