PRAYERTIME

THIS IS YOUR DAILY SCRIPTURE:

Ephesians 1:16-18 (CSB) I never stop giving thanks for you as I remember you in my prayers. 17 I pray that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, would give you the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him. 18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened so that you may know what is the hope of his calling, what is the wealth of his glorious inheritance in the saints.

THIS IS YOUR DAILY PRAYER:

Heavenly Father, I give thanks for my family. I will never stop thanking You for them. I pray that you will give them the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You. PARENT PRE-READING:

Job 12:13 CSB

Wisdom and strength belong to God; counsel and understanding are his.

CONVERSATION STARTER:

SCRIPTURAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

In verse 4 it says, "If you seek it like silver" What do you think "It" is referring to?

How can we see God's wisdom in his word?
