• <u>INTRO</u>

Welcome back to Prayer Service! We took a little break for the holidays, and now we're continuing our journey of praying through the Psalms—even as the church has begun the journey of reading through the whole Bible in 2021! We're picking back up tonight with a *powerful psalm*, number 18. We'll need to break this into two weeks, because it's long-actually, the fourth-longest Psalm, 50 verses. We'll read a few passages from the first half tonight, and we'll finish the second half next week. This Psalm, like many, is attributed to David: the description says he sang these words to the Lord after he was delivered from his enemies, from the vengeful king Saul. The powerful thing about many parts of the Old Testament is that we can see them through multiple lenses: these words vividly describe a particular time and situation, they stand as a testimony of David's experience of God's deliverance and power. Through another lens, we can see how these words prophetically point to the victory of King Jesus, who was delivered from death by the power of God for our own salvation. Finally, we can sing these words with king David: while we may not have experienced anything like he did here, we have experienced the powerful salvation of God in Christ—at a greater scope than perhaps David would have imagined. God works in amazing ways! In the ongoing turmoil of the world, be encouraged tonight. Let's pray.

PAUSE

"As I enter prayer now, I pause to be still; to breathe slowly; to re-center my scattered senses upon the presence of God." (Lectio365) *Pause and pray.*

As we read **Psalm 18** together, be open with the parts that confuse or challenge you; meditate on the parts that stand out to you:

⁴⁴ I love you, LORD, my strength. ² The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. ³ I called to the LORD, who is worthy of praise, and I have been saved from my enemies. ⁴ The cords of death entangled me; the torrents of destruction overwhelmed me. ⁵ The cords of the grave coiled around me; the snares of death confronted me. ⁶ In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears... ¹³ The LORD thundered from heaven; the voice of the Most High resounded. He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters...

¹⁷ He rescued me from my powerful enemy, from my foes, who were too strong for me. ¹⁸ They confronted me in the day of my disaster, but the LORD was my support. ¹⁹ He brought me out into a spacious place; he rescued me because he delighted in me." (Psalm 18:1-6, 13, 17-19)

• PSALM 18:1-6

⁴¹ I love you, LORD, my strength. ² The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. ³ I called to the LORD, who is worthy of praise, and I have been saved from my enemies. ⁴ The cords of death entangled me; the torrents of destruction overwhelmed me. ⁵ The cords of the grave coiled around me; the snares of death confronted me. ⁶ In my distress I called to the LORD; I cried to my God for help. From his temple he heard my voice; my cry came before him, into his ears...

Reread this passage again a few times, slowly. Ask the Lord to speak to you and guide you. What words or phrases are standing out? Meditate and pray on those words. *Pause and pray.*

• PSALM 18:13, 17-19

¹³ The LORD thundered from heaven; the voice of the Most High resounded. He reached down from on high and took hold of me; he drew me out of deep waters... ¹⁷ He rescued me from my powerful enemy, from my foes, who were too strong for me. ¹⁸ They confronted me in the day of my disaster, but the LORD was my support. ¹⁹ He brought me out into a spacious place; he rescued me because he delighted in me."

Is our faith like David's? Do we trust that, in the end, God will come through for us? The truth is, He already has—no matter what challenges we may suffer in this life. We may not have the kind of enemies David experienced here—ours is greater. The New Testament reminds us that our battle is not against flesh and blood, but against the spiritual powers of evil—the Enemy himself (Ephesians 6). We would be trapped, without hope, if God hadn't come through, if Jesus hadn't come to deliver us. But we have been delivered. We have been saved. *God delighted in us and gave His own Son,* "…that whoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life," (John 3:16). If this is true, who or what could possibly stand against us? What could ever separate us from the love of God? (Romans 8) We can sing with every bit of passion and praise as David did—and more.

Do you feel that today? Do you believe, no matter what present fears or trails, that God has saved you? Ask God to assure you of the salvation you have in Christ and to bring to salvation those you know who haven't yet trusted in Him. *Pause and pray.*
