Plans for Restarting Classes

Plans for Restarting Classes on Sunday Mornings

We plan to restart Bible Classes on Sunday Mornings January 24, 2021. We will still be offering two worship services, but the start times will be adjusted to allow an hour for Bible Classes between the two worship services. The proposed schedule is:

8:30 for First Service; 9:45 for Bible Classes; 11:00 for Second Service

When we restart our Sunday Morning Bible Classes, we will offer classes for all ages Cradle Roll through Adults. The Adult classes will include a Bible text study (1&2 Peter taught by Mike Dacus in Auditorium) and the GPS Class ("Parenting through Faith Challenges" taught by David Bearden). Taylor Holt will also be offering a Young Adult Bible Class in Room 109 (College Age, but not just for College Students) on Sunday mornings.

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Plans for Restarting Class Continued

The children below PK will go directly to their classes. The school age children will begin their class time with a 10-to-15-minute introduction time to set a common faith theme, to sing, and pray. During this time, the PK-2nd Grade will meet together in the Loft, the 3-5th Grade will meet together in the Orange Room, and the 6th-12th Grade will meet together in the Youth Ministry Room; then they break into their classes as indicated above for an age-appropriate lesson.

We do not plan to resume the "Worship Warriors" children's worship program during the Sunday morning worship services until we move back to one worship service on Sunday morning.

On Wednesday Nights, <u>WE ARE NOT</u> planning a Wednesday night children's ministry program at the building, but Megan is developing a virtual Wednesday Night class for the children and their parents. In preparation for our virtual family devotional Wednesdays next semester, please start joining the Facebook group: "Virtual Family Devotional (GSCC Families)." David will offer a Bible Study called "Getting to Know Jesus through the Old Testament," in the auditorium at 6:00. Le Jones will be leading the "Singing Class" in Room 109.

For Sunday Nights, it is our hope that by restarting our Sunday morning Bible classes, we can free more time for small groups on Sunday afternoons and evenings. We are working on a relaunch of our small group ministry in February. The leadership will be encouraging small groups to meet twice a month on the first and third Sundays of each month. We will have at least one small group that meets at the building on the 1st and 3rd Sunday nights of the month. Sermon follow-up material ("It Is More Than Restarting") will be furnished to small group leaders as Bible Study curriculum. There will be a meeting about our small group ministry Sunday Night, Jan. 17 at 5:00 in the auditorium. The current Family Bible Class will be offered on the second and fourth Sunday nights of the month (resuming Jan. 24). A worship service will also be offered at the building on the 2nd and 4th Sunday nights (starting Jan. 24), and we would also like to resume the 5th Sunday Singings (starting Jan. 31).

We will share more details about our restart plans for Jan. 24, at our Lunch Meeting in the Family Center, this Sunday, Jan. 10. (for those have RSVP by noon Saturday, 1/9/2021.)
