## 2020-2021 Leadership Family Ballot

The elders postponed our Congregational Ballot Meeting [normally held in August] in hopes of being able to meet in person in January. However, because of the current indefinite "Stay-at-Home" order, we will have to conduct that meeting virtually. Here is our plan on how to do that:

- 1) Today you will find in your bulletin the elder-proposed slate of 39 leaders [27 deacons and 12 elders]. As you can see there are only 12 that are up for reelection. - 2) Next week we will provide two opportunities to interact with the elders regarding the ballot. After each worship service on Sunday, 1/10/21, there will be a brief in-person forum in the patio. Then, at 7 PM on Monday [1/11/21] there will be a zoom meeting in the Prayer Zoom Room that will be open to everyone.
- 3) Following those two meetings, a final ballot will be emailed to each member. Members will be able to submit their ballot electronically or in person at the office (either during the week or on Sunday, 1/17/21 after the patio service). Ballots received by 1 PM on Sunday, January 17th will be counted and the results published by email and the following week's bulletin.

## Worship Venue Plan

Thanks so much to those of you who responded to the worship venue survey! After praying and considering your responses, the elders agreed that for the foreseeable future, we will continue to livestream our "in-person" worship services from the patio [English 9 AM; Spanish 10:45 AM]. If/when inclement weather is predicted on a Sunday [eg. 30% chance of rain, strong winds, or extreme cold], we will inform you by email and a fb post that we are moving the live-stream equipment into the worship center to protect it. We encourage anyone who is at risk [or shielding someone who is at risk] to worship at home. Those who are willing to practice the three "W's" [watch their distance, wear masks, and wash their hands] will of course be welcome to worship indoors on those "rainy Sundays".
